

## An Outline of Luke 14:7-24

A <sup>7</sup>So He told a parable to those who were <u>invited</u>, when He noted how they chose the best places ("first position"), saying to them: <sup>8</sup> "When you are invited by anyone to a wedding feast, do not sit down in the best place ("first position"), lest one more honorable than you be invited by him; <sup>9</sup> and he who invited you and him come and say to you, 'Give place to this man,' and then you begin with shame to take the lowest place. <sup>10</sup> But when you are invited, go and sit down in the lowest place, so that when he who invited you comes he may say to you, 'Friend, go up higher.' Then you will have glory in the presence of those who sit at the table with you. <sup>11</sup> For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."

**B** <sup>12</sup>Then He also said to him who invited Him, "When you give a dinner or a supper, do not ask your friends, your brothers, your relatives, nor rich neighbors, lest they also invite you back, and you be repaid. <sup>13</sup> But when you give a feast, invite *the* **poor**, *the* **maimed**, *the* **lame**, *the* **blind**. <sup>14</sup> And you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you; for you shall be repaid at the resurrection of the just."

 $\mathbf{C}$  <sup>15</sup> Now when one of those who sat at the table with Him heard these things, he said to Him, "Blessed *is* he who shall eat bread in the kingdom of God!"

**A'** <sup>16</sup> Then He said to him, "A certain man gave a great supper and invited many, <sup>17</sup> and sent his servant at supper time to say to those who were <u>invited</u>, 'Come, for all things are now ready.' <sup>18</sup> But they all with one accord began to make excuses. The first said to him, 'I have bought a piece of ground, and I must go and see it. I ask you to have me excused.' <sup>19</sup> And another said, 'I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I am going to test them. I ask you to have me excused.' <sup>20</sup> Still another said, 'I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.'

**B'** <sup>21</sup> So that servant came and reported these things to his master. Then the master of the house, being angry, said to his servant, 'Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in here *the* poor and *the* maimed and *the* lame and *the* blind.'

**C'** <sup>22</sup> And the servant said, 'Master, it is done as you commanded, and still there is room.' <sup>23</sup> Then the master said to the servant, 'Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel *them* to come in, that my house may be filled. <sup>24</sup> For I say to you that none of those men who were invited shall taste my supper.' "
