

A Textual Outline of 2 Peter 3:1-13

The Thesis ¹Beloved, I now write to you this second epistle (in *both of* which I stir up your pure minds by way of reminder), ² that you may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us, the apostles of the Lord and Savior,

A ³knowing this first: that scoffers will come in the last days, walking according to their own lusts, ⁴ and saying, "Where is the promise of His coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as *they were* from the beginning of creation." ⁵ For this they willfully forget: that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water, ⁶ by which the world *that* then existed perished, being flooded with water. ⁷ But the heavens and the earth *which* are now preserved by the same word, are reserved for <u>fire</u> until the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

B ⁸ But, beloved, <u>do not forget</u> this one thing, that with the Lord one day *is* as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. ⁹ The Lord is not slack concerning *His* promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

A' ¹⁰ But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. ¹¹ Therefore, since all these things will be <u>dissolved</u>,

B' what manner *of persons* ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, ¹² **looking** for and hastening the coming of the day of God,

A' because of which the heavens will be <u>dissolved</u>, being on <u>fire</u>, and the elements will <u>melt</u> with fervent heat?

B' ¹³ Nevertheless we, according to His promise, <u>look</u> for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

The Outline of 2 Peter 3:1-13

The Thesis Reminder to be Mindful of all that is said in the Scriptures

- A / A' Judgment and Fall of the Unsaved ("them")
- **B / B'** Presence with Jesus for the Saved ("us")

Peter's Reminders in 2 Peter 3:1-13

- 1. Trust the entirety of the Word of God, OT and NT.
- 2. There will be scoffers (lifestyle and verbal) against Jesus and our faith.
- 3. God has everything under control.
- 4. God is not slack, lazy, or slow.
- 5. God is not hasty or reckless.
- 6. God's doesn't want anyone to perish.
- 7. God wants all to come to repentance.
- 8. God will judge all sin.
- 9. Trust God's timing in all things and remain steadfast.
- 10. Live out holiness and godliness. Stay focused.
- 11. Eagerly await the coming of Jesus.
