

A Textual Outline of 1 Peter 5:1-4

A The elders who are among you I exhort, I who am a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that will be revealed:

B ² Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers,

C <u>not</u> by compulsion but willingly, <u>not</u> for dishonest gain but eagerly; ³<u>nor</u> as being lords over those entrusted to you,

B' but being examples to the flock;

A' ⁴ and when the <u>Chief Shepherd</u> appears, you will receive the crown of <u>glory</u> that does not fade away.

⁵ Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to *your* elders.

A Yes, all of you be submissive to one another,

B and <u>be clothed with humility</u>, for "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

⁶ Therefore <u>humble yourselves</u> under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time,

A' ⁷ casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.
