## **MIDWEEK DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1. The sermon showed how Joseph's sufferings were like Jesus' sufferings. How does knowing Jesus experienced injustice and suffering give you hope when facing hard times?
2. The sermon said: "Without God's grace changing us, we can't properly overcome sin and temptation!" How have you experienced God's grace helping you fight against sin or temptation?
3. Even in prison, the warden put Joseph in charge because "the Lord was with him" (Genesis 39:21-23). When have you seen God's favor and blessing on your life, even in a difficult situation?
4. Even though Joseph was faithful, he still ended up in prison unfairly (Genesis 39:19-20). Have you ever felt mistreated or that life was unfair to you, even though you were trying to follow God? How did you respond?
