Read God's Word Aloud

Discuss God's Word and God's World

Important: The goal is never to “get through” every question like a checklist. It’s ok to linger on a few questions if they spark sanctifying discussion or opportunities for intercessory prayer.

Start here: Take a few moments to reflect together on this week’s Bible passage. Share what stands out to you or what impacted you from Sunday’s sermon from the Scriptures.

- What do you think and feel about the idea that life is beyond your control? How did you experience that in 2025?
- In what ways do you try to control what is uncontrollable? Are you more likely to search for knowledge, try harder, or something else?
- When have you gotten something you really wanted only to discover it did not provide what you *really* wanted?
- In your life today, how are you experiencing that life is a gift from God? (Eccl. 3:13)
- What gifts from God are you most likely to miss when life is difficult or painful?
- During Sunday’s sermon, Jamin asked an important question. Take the time to discuss your answers together:
“What would it look like to center your life on the conviction that a happy God made you and gave you your life as a happy gift?”
- How does the gospel shape your understanding of God’s goodness and generosity?
- What three gifts from God are you most grateful for in your life right now?

Sanctificational Prayer Guidance

Praise God for your life. Worship him for giving your life and for sustaining it.
