Romans 8:28-29

28 And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose. 29 For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.

Discuss God's Word and God's World

Important: *The goal is never to “get through” every question like a checklist. It’s ok to linger on a few questions if they spark sanctifying discussion or opportunities for intercessory prayer.*

- What does it mean that "all things work together for good"? What does it not mean?
- How does Romans 8:28 encourage you when facing challenges?
- How should believers respond to the truth of God's sovereignty in their lives?
- How does this passage encourage you to trust God's plan for your life, even when you don't understand it? What keeps you from trusting God fully?
- In what ways does this passage affect how you see yourself?
- Where is God working to conform you into the image of Jesus? How can your home group pray for you in this area?
