Read God's Word Aloud

Mark 12:30 And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.

Matthew 5:13-16 13 “You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people's feet. 14 “You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. 16 In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

Discuss God's Word and God's World

Important: The goal is never to “get through” every question like a checklist. It's ok to linger on a few questions if they spark sanctifying discussion or opportunities for intercessory prayer.

- How do you understand the metaphor of being “salt of the earth?”
 - Have you lost your saltiness? How can you restore your saltiness?
 - Is there somewhere in your life that you are keeping your light hidden? Why do you think you are hiding it from others?
 - In what ways can you be salt in your everyday life? How might you need to shine your light throughout your week?
 - What are some specific ways that you can act like Jesus as explained in the passage this week?
