- I. We experience defeat when we elevate our preferences over God's purpose. (V. 2)
- II. Every choice of disobedience comes with consequences. (Vv. 1:3–17)
- III. God's love brings corrective discipline when we refuse to obey Him. (Vv. 2:1–2, 7)
- IV. God's plan for salvation was beyond Jonah's limited capacity. (Vv. 3:3–4, 10)
- V. God's grace is much deeper than Jonah's heart. (Vv. 4:1–3)
- VI. Our self-centered bitterness steals our joy and intimacy with God. (Vv. 4:3–4)
- VII. God's grace is centered in His heart for His people. (Vv. 4:10–11)
- VIII. God's grace reveals God's glory in His world. (Vv. Ps. 86:9; Ps. 119:1; Isa. 45:22; Rev. 5:9)
