Psalms 33 (NKJV)

- I. Recognize the Goodness of the Lord. (Vv. 1–3, 5)
 - A. Give Praise for God’s Word. (v. 4a, 6–9)
 - B. Give Praise for God’s work. (v. 4b, 10–12)
 - C. Give Praise for God’s watchfulness. (v. 13–19; Ps. 32:8; Ps. 34:15; Job 36:7; Isa. 34:15)

- II. Responding to the Goodness of the Lord. (Vv. 20-22)
 - A. Our Position before Him.
 1. We wait. (v. 20)
 2. We trust. (v. 21)
 3. We hope. (v. 22)

 - B. God’s Provision for us. (v. 20b; vv. 16-17; 19)
 1. His is our victorious helper.
 2. He is our sure protection.

 - C. Our promise to Him. (v. 21)

 - D. Our petition before Him. (v. 22)

Take Aways:

1. The Lord alone is worthy of our praise.
2. God’s word and will is powerfully being accomplished.
3. God is actively unfolding and caring for His people.
4. Our response to God’s goodness is to trust Him, obey Him and praise Him
