 - A. No one is beyond the power of Christ. V. 29
 - B. No evil is above the authority of Christ. James 2:19; Mat. 25:41; 2 Pet. 2:4; Rev. 20:3
- II. Transformation involves liberation and healing. Vv. 35-36; Mat. 12:22-29; Luke 11:24-26
 - A. Jesus alone sets us free.
 - B. Jesus alone saves us.
- III. Untransformed men reject Christ's presence because of self-centered fear. V. 37
- IV. Transformed men are commissioned to tell what God has done for them. Vv. 38-39; Luke 24:46-49

- 2. Real transformation involves a new life miracle.
