Twelve Principles of Giving Motivated by Grace.

- 1. Giving is not based on circumstances. (2 Cor. 8:1–4)
- 2. Financial giving must be preceded by self-giving. (2 Cor. 8:5)
- 3. We should all learn to excel in giving. (2 Cor. 8:6–7)
- 4. Genuine giving commitments should be completed. (2 Cor. 8:6, 10–11; 9:5)
