- I. Obedience is the fruit of trust/faith. (Vs. 8)
- II. Obedience does not seek self-gratification. (Vs. 9)

- IV. Obedience requires eternal perspective. (Vv. 10, 13–16)
- V. Obedience brings supernatural power into your life. (Vv. 11, 12)
- VI. Obedience demands submission to a sovereign God. (Vv. 13–15)
- VII. Obedience leads to sacrificial giving. (Vv. 17–19)
- VIII. Obedience requires personal suffering. (Vv. 24–26; 32–38; 2 Tim. 3:12; Phil. 1:29; 2 Cor. 4:7–11)
- IX. Obedience brings the approval of God. (Vv. 4, 5, 16, 39)
- X. Obedience results in eternal rewards. (Vv. 16b, Mt. 19:29; Mt. 10:39)
