IV. The cure for sin. 3:15, 21
A. God will provide a second Adam. V. 15; Rom. 5:12–21;

Gal. 4:4

B. God will provide a satisfying atonement. V. 21; Heb. 10:4, 11–13; 2 Cor. 5:21

C. God will provide a complete resolution. Rom. 5:17–21; 8:20–23; Isa. 11:5–10
