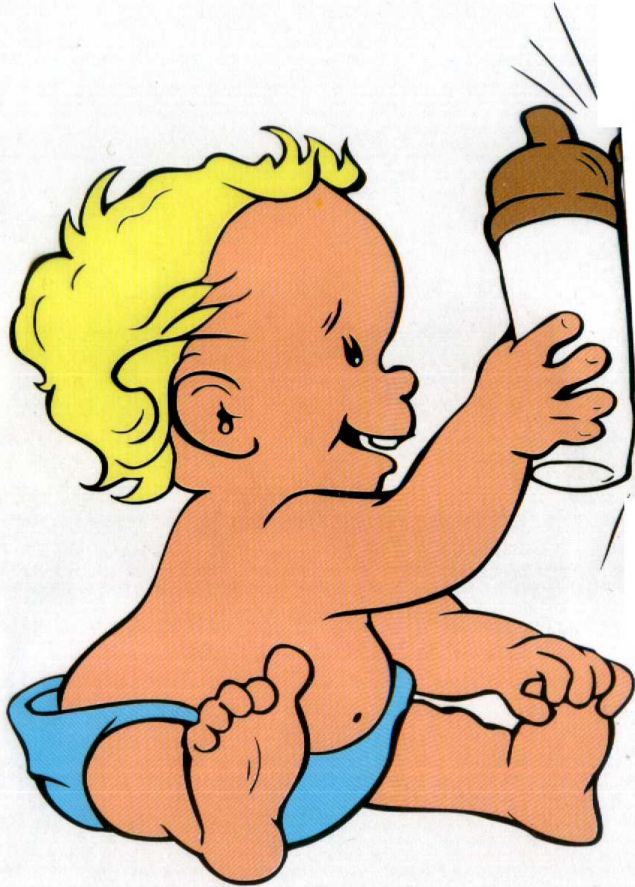
**Study and obey your Bible

- In 1 Peter 2:2, “**logos**” refers to the written word
- In **Matthew 4:4**, the Greek word for “word” is not logos, it is “**rhema**”.

- **Vine's Expository Dictionary of New Testament Words** says “the significance of **rhema** (as distinct from **logos**) is exemplified in **Ephesians 6:17**...here the reference is not to the whole Bible as such, but to the individual Scripture which the Spirit brings to our remembrance in time of need.”

1. Schedule a set time each day.

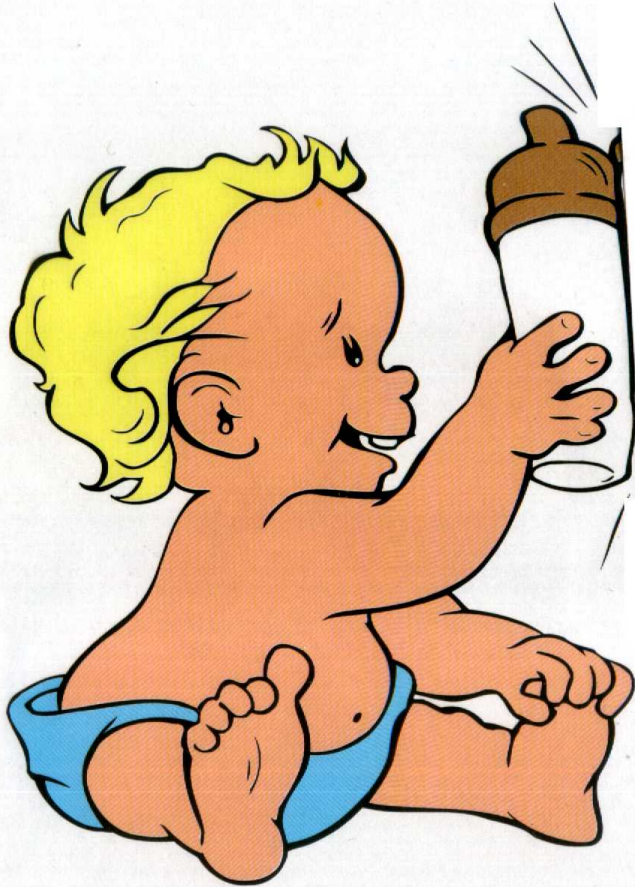
2. Select a spot/place.

3. Use an easy to read translation.

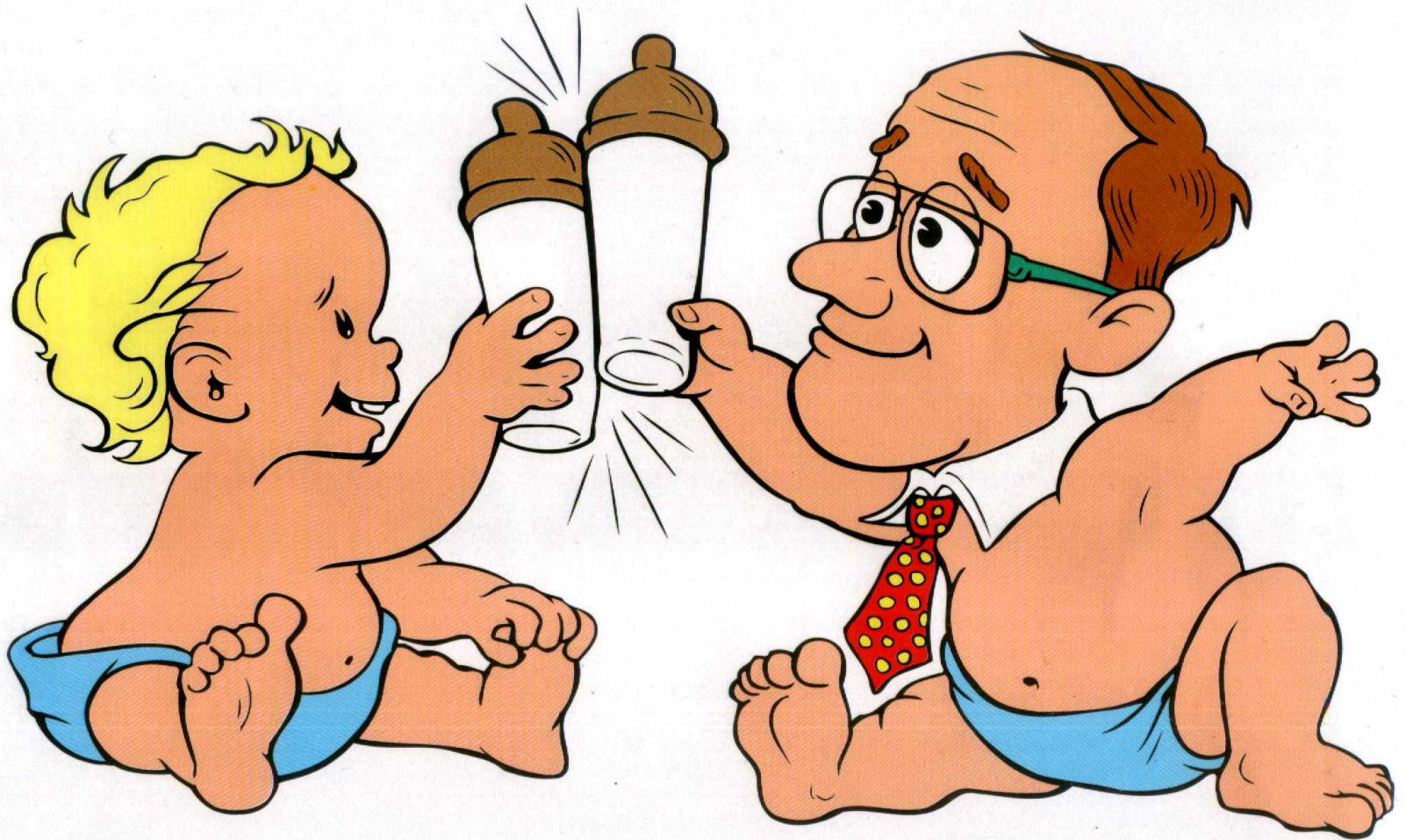
4. Read systematically.
