What is a disciple?

- 1. A person who follows Jesus.
- 2. A person who is being changed by Jesus.
- 3. A person on mission with Jesus. Matthew 28:18–20

What are the characteristics of a disciple of Jesus?

- 1. **Whole-hearted obedience.** (Luke 6:46; 14:26–27) "Obedience to Christ is a vital key to being a true disciple."
- Contagious Love. (Matt. 22:37–39; John 13:34–35; 15:12–13; Matt. 5:43–48)
 "Love for God transforms us. Love for others transforms the world."
 "Love is the most powerful weapon for defeating evil."
- 3. **Sacrificial Giving.** (Mark 10:45; Luke 9:23–25) "True followers of Jesus generously and sacrificially give their lives to help rescue others." "You will never transform the world for good by selfish living."
- 4. **Persuasive Witness.** (Acts 1:8; Rom. 1:16–17; 1Cor. 1:18–25; 2Cor. 5:10–11; 16–20; Eph. 6:19) "True Kingdom followers are committed to persuade other people to turn from sin and trust in Christ alone." "We must commit to boldly, prayerfully and lovingly present the gospel to all who will listen."
