TEXT: Psalms 126:1–6

- I. Going. (Vv. Ps. 126:6a; Matt. 4:19; Luke 9:23; Matt. 28:19–20; Luke 9:57–62)
 - A. Going means following Jesus.
 - B. Going requires trusting Jesus.
- II. Sowing. (Vv. Ps. 126:5; Matt. 13:3–9; 18–23; 1Pet. 1:23–25)
 - A. Sowing is an act of obedience.
 - B. Sowing is an act of faith.
 - C. Sowing is an act of sacrifice.
- III. Weeping. (Vv. Ps. 126:5; Isa. 22:4; Jer. 9:1, 17–21; 13:17; ;14:17; Luke 19:41; Acts 20:19–21, 31)
 - A. Weeping is from a broken heart.
 - B. Weeping is from a loving heart.
 - C. Weeping is from a compassionate heart.
- IV. Reaping. (Vv. Ps. 126:5; Luke 10:2; John 4:35, 36; Gal. 6:9)
 - A. Reaping requires seeing the harvest.
 - B. Reaping requires working in the harvest.
- V. Bringing. (Vv. Ps. 126:6; Prov. 11:30; Dan. 12:3; Phil. 4:1; 1Thes. 2:19–20)
 - A. Bringing is the fulfillment of God's promise.
 - B. Bringing is the fruit of God's work.
- VI. Singing. (Ps. 126:2–3; Ps. 126:1; Matt. 25:21)
 - A. Joyful singing when dreams become reality.
 - B. Joyful singing when lives are rescued.
 - C. Joyful singing when the Lord rejoices.
