- I. Hope is based on God's Revelation. (v. 15)
- II. Hope is rooted in Christ's Redemption and Resurrection. (Vv. 14; 1Cor. 15:1–4; Rom. 6:4–10)
- III. Hope rests in Christ's Return. (Vv. 16a; Ps. 33:6–9; John 11:43–44; John 5:25–28)
- IV. Hope anticipates the resurrection of the dead. (Vv. 4:16b; 1Cor. 15:20–23)
- V. Hope believes in our rapture and longs for our reunion. (Vv. 4:17; 2Thes 2:1)
- VI. Hope comforts us and reminds us that death is defeated. (v. 4:18)

- 1. God loves you and saves you from death.
- 2. The grave is not final.
- 3. At death, we are present with the Lord.
- 4. Christ is coming again.
- 5. We will all be given new bodies.
- 6. We will be re-united with our loved ones and Christ.
