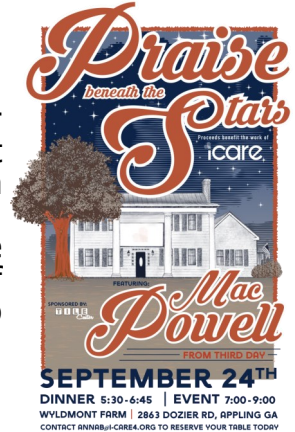
The Sound will be here in concert Thursday, September 29th at 7:00 pm. No admission charge; a love offering will be received.
