I Am Valuable

- I (Your Name) am God's child
 - John 1:12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:
- I (Your Name) am a part of the true vine, and a channel of Christ's life
 - John 15:5 I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit.
- I (Your Name) am a friend of Christ
 - John 15:15 Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you.
- I (Your Name) am a joint heir with Christ, I share Christ's inheritance with Him
 - Romans 8:17 'and if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.
- I (Your Name) am God's co-worker
 - I Corinthians 3:9 'For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.
- I (Your Name) am God's temple
 - I Corinthians 3:16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?
- I (Your Name) have been adopted by God as His son
 - Ephesians 1:5-6 'having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,
- I (Your Name) have an inheritance in Christ
 - Ephesians 1:11 'having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, in whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:
- I (Your Name) have been made alive in Christ and I am seated with Christ in the heavenly places
 - Ephesians 2:5-6 'even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) and hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:
- I (Your Name) am God's workmanship, His handiwork
 - Ephesians 2:10 'For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.'

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- Christ Himself is in (Your Name)
 - Colossians 1:27 'to whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.'
- My life is hidden with Christ in God
 - Colossians 3:3 'For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.'

I Am Loved

- I (Your Name) have eternal life in Christ
 - John 3:15-16 'that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.'
- I (Your Name) am not judged by God, because I am in Christ
 - John 3:18 'He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.'
- I (Your Name) remain in Christ's love
 - John 15:9-10 'As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love. If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.'
- I (Your Name) am a son of God
 - Romans 8:14-15 'For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. '
- I (Your Name) cannot be separated from the love of God
 - Romans 8:35-36, 38-39 'Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.'
- I (Your Name) may approach God with boldness and confidence
 - Ephesians 3:12 'in whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him.'

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- I (Your Name) have been rescued from the domain of Satan's rule and transferred to the kingdom of Christ
 - Colossians 1:13-14 'who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: in whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins: '
- I (Your Name) may come boldly before the throne of grace through Jesus Christ to receive mercy
 - Hebrews 4:16 'Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.'

I am Victorious

- I (Your Name) have been set free
 - John 8:31-32 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, *then* are ye my disciples indeed; and ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.
- I (Your Name) died with Christ and I died to the power of sin's rule over his life
 - Romans 6:1-4 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein? Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
- I (Your Name) am more than a conqueror in Christ
 - Romans 8:37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.
- I (Your Name) am led triumphantly by Christ
 - II Corinthians 2:14 Now thanks *be* unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.
- I (Your Name) was crucified with Christ
 - Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
- I (Your Name) can do all things through Christ
 - Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.
- I (Your Name) have been given a spirit of power, love, and self control

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- II Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- I (Your Name) have overcome the world
 - I John 5:4-5 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, *even* our faith. Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

I Am Complete

- I (Your Name) am joined with Christ, and I am one spirit with Him
 - I Corinthians 6:17 But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.
- I (Your Name) am a new creation
 - II Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- I (Your Name) am the righteousness of God in Christ
 - II Corinthians 5:21 For he hath made him *to be* sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.
- I (Your Name) have been blessed with every spiritual blessing
 - Ephesians 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly *places* in Christ:
- I (Your Name) have Christ's mind
 - Phillipians 2:5-7 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: but made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:
- I (Your Name) am firmly rooted in Christ and I am being built up and established in Him
 - Colossians 2:6-7 As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, *so* walk ye in him: rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving.
- I (Your Name) have been made complete in Christ
 - Colossians 2:10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

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I Am Chosen

- I (Your Name) have been chosen and appointed by Christ to bear His fruit
 - John 15:16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.
- I (Your Name) have been established, anointed, and sealed in Christ
 - II Corinthians 1:21-22 Now he which stablisheth us with you in Christ, and hath anointed us, *is* God; who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts
- I (Your Name) have been reconciled to God and I am a minister of reconciliation
 - II Corinthians 5:18-19 And all things *are* of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; to wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.
- I (Your Name) have been chosen by God to be holy
 - Ephesians 1:4 according as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:
- I (Your Name) have been given a holy calling
 - II Timothy 1:9 who hath saved us, and called *us* with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,
- I (Your Name) am washed and renewed by the Holy Spirit
 - Titus 3:5 not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;
- I (Your Name) am a member of a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession
 - I Peter 2:9 But ye *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light:
- I (Your Name) have boldness and am not ashamed
 - I John 2:28 And now, little children, abide in him; that, when he shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be ashamed before him at his coming.

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I Am Forgiven

- I (Your Name) have passed from death to life in Christ
 - John 5:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.
- I (Your Name) have been justified through grace
 - Romans 3:24 being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:
- I (Your Name) have been justified, completely forgiven, made righteous, and have peace
 - Romans 5:1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:
- I (Your Name) am forever free from condemnation
 - Romans 8:1-2 *There is* therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. 2For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.
- I (Your Name) am free from any condemning charges against me
 - Romans 8:31-34 What shall we then say to these things? If God *be* for us, who *can be* against us? He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? *It is* God that justifieth. Who *is* he that condemneth? *It is* Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.
- I (Your Name) have been redeemed and forgiven and I am a recipient of His rich grace
 - Ephesians 1:7-8 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace; wherein he hath abounded toward us in all wisdom and prudence;
- I (Your Name) have been forgiven in Christ
 - Ephesians 4:32 and be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.
