- I. Can I Lose My Salvation?
- A. Play Spirit, Soul & Body video. (Let's pause it at each break for discussion.)
1. (John 4:24) God is Spirit and He relates to mankind through their spirit.
 2. (1 Cor. 6:17 AMP) Your spirit is perfect and righteous just like Jesus.
 - a. (2 Cor. 5:21) Jesus became sin so we could be righteous.
 - b. (Eph. 4:23-24) the new man, true righteousness and holiness.
 - c. (Eph. 1:13-14) Your spirit has been sealed with the Holy Spirit until the redemption of the purchased possession (your new body and renewed soul).
 - d. (Eph. 1:7; Col. 2:13) All of the born-again believers' sin is forgiven past, present and future.
 3. (1 John 2:1-2) You can sin in your body and mind but not in your spirit.
 - a. (1 John 3:6-9) Your born-again spirit cannot sin neither can sin enter into your spirit.
 - b. (Rom. 3:23) We all sin and are falling short of the glory of God.
 - (Rom. 14:23) “...for whatever is not from faith is sin.”
 - (Jas. 2:10) “For whoever shall keep the whole law, and yet stumble in one point, he is guilty of all.”
 - (Jas. 4:17) “Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin.”
 4. If all of our sin is forgiven why not continue to sin?
 - a. (Rom. 3:8; 6:1, 15) Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? God forbid!
 - b. (Rom. 6:1, 16) Paul gave two reasons we should live holy

- c. Must I confess every sin I commit to put them “under the blood” after I’m born-again according to 1 John 1:9?
- No, that’s not practical or possible!
