- I. Blessing and Miracles
 - A. Walking in the Blessing vs. Miracles
 1. There are basically two ways to receive from God: blessing and miracles.
 - a. The blessing is God's divine favor spoken over you. Walking in God's blessing requires cooperating with natural and spiritual laws.
 - (Rom. 8:2 AMP)
 - (Rom. 3:27)
 - b. Three characteristics of the blessing:
 - prevents crisis from overtaking you.
 - is permanent
 - is abundant
 - c. (Num. 6:22-27) The blessing is a spiritual law that is voice activated. The blessing is not "the things:" houses, cars, health etc. Things are the by-product of the blessing.
 - (Ps. 3:8; [24:5-6 AMP])
 - (Prov. 8:32-36; [10:22 AMP])
 2. A miracle is an extraordinary event manifesting divine intervention in human affairs. A miracle may defy natural laws but will cooperate with spiritual laws.
 - a. A miracle may or may not be God's best depending on the circumstances.
 - b. A miracle:
 - requires a crisis.
 - is temporary and not permanent.
 - is usually just enough.
 - c. (John 2:1-11)
 - (Matt. 14:14-21)
 - (Matt. 15:32-37)
 - (*ref. Exo. 16*) Manna in the wilderness
