- I. Being Fully Persuaded
 - A. How to Be Fully Persuaded
 1. (Rom. 4:16 NLT) “...*Abraham is the father of all who believe.*”
 2. (Rom. 4:17-24 NLT) “...*and **being fully persuaded** that what He had promised He was also able to perform...*”
KJV
 - a. Being fully persuaded is believing God with all your heart despite any physical evidence to the contrary.
 3. What’s involved with being fully persuaded?
 - a. 3 things:
 - Knowing the promise of God for your situation.
 - Embracing the promise with all your heart.
 - Not considering anything contrary to the promise.
 - B. Do You Know the Promise?
 1. You must know the promise of God for your situation.
 - a. “*Faith begins where the will of God is known.*”
 - (1 John 5:14-15 AMP)
 - God’s will is revealed in His Word!
 - b. (Heb. 6:12-18) God swore on Himself. He made a covenant with Himself (Jesus) man being His silent, resting partner. (Gen. 15:1-18)
 - (John 1:1-4, 14 KJV)
 - (Ps. 89:33-35 NLT)
 - (Prov. 30:5 NLT)
 - (Num. 23:19-21 NLT)
 - (Tit. 1:2)
 - c. (2 Pet. 1:2-4) There’s a promise for all your needs and for all your God-given dreams and desires.
 - (Phil. 4:19 AMP) All your needs.
 - (Ps. 37:4 AMP) Desires of your heart.
