 - 1. The Proverbs are the concentrated wisdom of God in hardcopy. The Proverbs expose natural and spiritual laws. True success in life is a matter of cooperating with natural/spiritual laws.

 - b. (Eccl. 12:13-14 NIV) The conclusion of the matter of life— "Fear God. Do what He tells you." (MSG)
 - 2. (Prov. 2:1-5 AMP) the first benefit mentioned in the proverbs of seeking God's wisdom is the fear of the LORD.
 - a. What is the Fear of the Lord?
 - (Isa. 11:1-3) It is not terror, condemnation, or dread of God.
 - It is to have reverential, awe, respect, honor, awareness of, obedience and submission to who God is and what He says above everything else.
 - (Ps. 34:8-11) The fear of the LORD is developed by knowing God through a true relationship with Jesus.
