What is baptism?

- βαπτω; Bapto (4x) — to dip
- βαπτίζω; Baptizo (72x) — to dip completely
- Baptism is complete immersion
- Baptism by immersion is a visual and symbolic demonstration of an individual's union with Christ. It is a sign that a person's former life has been put to death and it represents a release from the deathly grip of sin.
- Baptism is an outward and visible sign of an inward and spiritual change.

Baptism is a symbol of the Gospel

- Christ died for sins
- Christ was buried
- Christ rose from the dead

Baptism is a symbol of our salvation

- An outward sign of an inward change
- Symbol of confession
- Symbol of surrender
- Symbol of belief
- Baptism follows salvation

Baptism is a symbol of our identification

- I belong to Jesus
- Buried with Him
- Raised with Him

Baptism is a symbol of obedience

- Obedience by being baptized
- Obedience by making disciples
- Obedience by baptizing disciples
- Obedience by teaching obedience
