

Scripture:

1 Corinthians 15:1-6

Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep.

To be fluent in the Gospel, we need to understand the *story* of God.

- Creation: Where is my identity?
- Fall: What is wrong here?
- Rescue: What can fix this?
- Restoration: Where is hope?

To be fluent in the Gospel, we need to be *reminded* of the Good News

- The Good News is always needed
- The Good News is always the same
- The Good News is forever

To be fluent in the Gospel, we need to *embrace* the *whole* Gospel

- The whole Gospel addresses who...Christ
- The whole Gospel addresses what...sin
- The whole Gospel addresses how...death, burial, and resurrection
- The whole Gospel addresses when...future resurrection
- The whole Gospel addresses why...the love of God.
