- It accurately conveys key _____ 1 Chronicles 29:11; Revelation 5:13
- It is a _____ – a short statement or hymn of praise to God, concisely expressing theological truth Romans 11:36; Ephesians 3:20-21; 1 Timothy 1:17

So, where do we find these truths in Scripture?

- “**For Yours is the Kingdom**” – Acknowledges God’s _____ over all creation Psalm 22:28, 90:2, 103:19; Daniel 4:3; Isaiah 46:9-10; Lamentations 5:19; Romans 13:1; Revelation 11:15
- “and **the power**” – recognizes God as _____ and without limitations Jeremiah 32:17; Deuteronomy 10:17; Job 42:2; Matthew 19:26; Romans 1:20
- “and **the glory**” – affirms that God _____ deserves all honor and praise Isaiah 6:3, 42:8; Romans 11:36; Revelation 21:23
- “**forever**” – emphasizes the _____ nature of God’s reign, power and glory Psalm 145:13; Exodus 15:18; Daniel 4:34; Isaiah 40:28; Romans 1:20; Hebrews 13:8; Revelation 4:9-10
- “**Amen**” – means, “truly,” or “so be it,” a seal of _____ and agreement with everything that has been prayed Nehemiah 8:6; 2 Corinthians 1:20; Revelation 7:12
