For Men	
· Husbands: your wives as Christ loved the church	1 Corinthians 13
- This means: Lovingly your wife	
Pay the highest price	
Take full responsibility	
For Women	
Wives: to your own husbands as to the Lord	
- This means: Respectfully your husband	Hebrews 13:17
Choose encouragement over nagging	

Choose faith over fear

²²**Wives**, <u>submit</u> to <u>your own husbands</u>, <u>as to the Lord</u>. ²³For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior. ²⁴Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands.

²⁵**Husbands**, <u>love your wives</u>, <u>as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her</u>, ²⁶that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, ²⁷so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish. ²⁸In the same way husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. ²⁹For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ does the church, ³⁰because we are members of his body. ³¹"Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." ³²This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church. ³³However, let each one of you love his wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.
