### Lessons for Children

- \_\_\_\_\_ (action) (v. 1)
  - Listen attentively and put yourselves under the words and authority of your parents
- \_\_\_\_\_ (attitude) (v. 2)
  - Consider them valuable, honor and give aid *Genesis 2:24; Ephesians 5:3*
- WHY? This is what is \_\_\_\_\_ to the Lord *Colossians 3:20*

<sup>4</sup>**Fathers**, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.  
-Ephesians 6:4 ESV

### Lessons for Parents, especially Fathers

- Negative Command: \_\_\_\_\_ provoke your children to anger (v. 4a) *Colossians 3:21*
- Positive Command: \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ your children in the Lord (v. 4b) *Proverbs 4:1-4*
  - The purpose of parenting is to raise up another \_\_\_\_\_ *Deuteronomy 6:4-9*
  - How? Prioritize the things of God!
    - A \_\_\_\_\_-saturated home
    - A \_\_\_\_\_ home

    - Make \_\_\_\_\_ participation a top priority

### How do parents and children practice mutual submission?

- Children obey/honor their parents, submitting to their \_\_\_\_\_
