BIG IDEA: Salvation is INITIATED by God, RESPONDED to by people, and MULTIPLIED through relationships!

³⁵ The next day again John was standing with two of his disciples, ³⁶ and he looked at Jesus as he walked by and said, “Behold, the Lamb of God!” ³⁷ The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus. ³⁸ Jesus turned and saw them following and said to them, “**What are you seeking?**” And they said to him, “Rabbi” (which means Teacher), “where are you staying?” ³⁹ He said to them, “**Come and you will see.**” So they came and saw where he was staying, and they stayed with him that day, for it was about the tenth hour. ⁴⁰ One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. ⁴¹ He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, “We have found the Messiah” (which means Christ). ⁴² He brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, “**You are Simon the son of John. You shall be called Cephas**” (which means Peter).

John 1:35-42 ESV

WHY does it matter/WHAT does it mean for me?

1. Salvation is a DIVINE act that demands a HUMAN response

- God's part...
 - Salvation is by GRACE, not human WORKS
Acts 15:11; Romans 3:20-30; Ephesians 2:4-5
- My part...
 - Sinners must REPENT *Mark 6:12; Luke 5:32, 13:3; Acts 2:38; 2 Peter 3:9*
 - Believe in JESUS CHRIST *John 1:12, 3:15-18; 1 John 3:23, 5:1, 13*

2. QUESTIONS are better than answers

- Powerful questions expose the HEART
- Jesus powerful question: WHAT ARE YOU SEEKING? *John 1:28*

3. An invitation that can be life-changing: COME and SEE! John 1:39, 46

- The New Testament pattern that still applies today: God uses FOUND people to FIND people

Bonus: What's baptism all about?
