Jesus in Wandering... Passover

Passover	In the Old Testament	In the New Testament
Instruction to Sacrifice	“Take...a lamb...and...kill it” (Exodus 12:3,6)	“Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world” (John 1:29)
Condition of Sacrifice	“Your lamb shall be without blemish” (Exodus 12:5)	“...the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot” (1 Peter 1:19)
Reason for Sacrifice	“I will execute judgment” (Exodus 12:12)	“And...it is appointed for men to die once, but after this is the judgment” (Hebrews 9:27)
Application of Sacrifice	“Every man shall take for himself a lamb” (Exodus 12:3)	“Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved” (Acts 4:12)
Result of Sacrifice	“The Lord will pass over the door and not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike you” (Exodus 12:23)	“There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus” (Romans 8:1)
