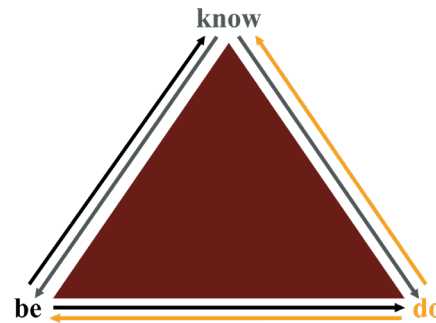
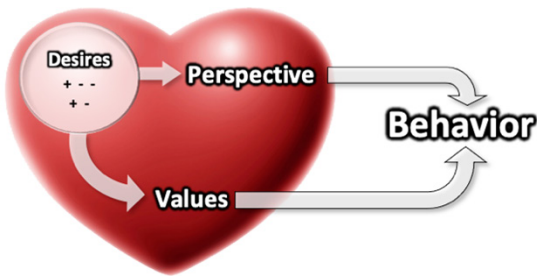
Abiding in Jesus means growing in 3 areas:

- **Knowledge** - “Stuff” we need to **KNOW** *2 Peter 3:18; Colossians 1:9*
- **Character** - The process of **BECOMING** a specific kind of person *Colossians 3:10*
- **Skill** - Ability to **DO** His mission *Romans 8:28, Matthew 28:19-20*

Working definition of a disciple:

Matthew 4:19

Someone who is **following** Jesus, **being changed** by Jesus, and is **committed** to the mission of Jesus
