Proverbs 16:2 WRONG MOTIVES

Proverbs 29:25; Galatians 1:10 SOCIAL PRESSURE

## Rethinking Christmas...

John 3:16-17; Luke 2:4-7

Ephesians 5:15-16 Leads to **SPENDING INTENTIONALLY** 

Means I focus on:

What would PLEASE GOD

Ecclesiastes 2:26

How to truly BLESS OTHERS

Proverbs 11:25; 1 John 3:17; Matthew 2:11

**CONTENTMENT** rather than **CONSUMPTION** 

Philippians 4:11-12; 1 Timothy 6:6-8; Hebrews 13:5
