Believable part 6: The Holy Spirit

John 16: ⁷ But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. ⁸ When he comes, he will prove the world to be in the wrong about sin and righteousness and judgment: ⁹ about sin, because people do not believe in me; ¹⁰ about righteousness, because I am going to the Father, where you can see me no longer; ¹¹ and about judgment, because the prince of this world now stands condemned. ¹² "I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. ¹³ But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.

Acts 1: ⁷ He said to them: "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. ⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Scripture reveals the Holy Spirit is your <u>advocate</u>.

- The Holy Spirit has come to <u>argue</u>.
- The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of <u>Truth</u>.

Romans 8: ¹⁶ The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.

The Holy Spirit comes to <u>empower</u> you to continue <u>Christ's</u> work.

The Holy Spirit has come – not do things <u>for</u> you, but <u>with</u> you.
