The Enactment of the Covenant and the New Covenant

I. The enactment of the covenant *Exodus 24:3-8*

³And Moses came and told the people all the words of Jehovah and all the ordinances; and all the people answered with one voice and said, All the words which Jehovah has spoken we will do. ⁴And Moses wrote down all the words of Jehovah. And he rose up early in the morning and <u>built an altar</u> at the base of the mountain <u>and twelve pillars</u> for the twelve tribes of Israel. ⁵And he sent young men of the children of Israel, who <u>offered burnt offerings and sacrificed peace offerings</u> of bulls to Jehovah. ⁶And Moses took half of the blood and put it in basins, and half of the blood he sprinkled on the altar. ⁷And he took the book of the covenant and read it in the hearing of the people; and they said, All that Jehovah has spoken we will do, and we will be obedient. ⁸So Moses took the blood and sprinkled it on the people and said, <u>Here is the blood of the covenant</u>, which Jehovah has made with you in accordance with all these words.

II. The new covenant Jeremiah 31:31-32

³¹Indeed, days are coming, declares Jehovah, when <u>I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah</u>, ³²Not like the covenant which I made with their fathers in the day I took them by their hand to bring them out from the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, although I was their Husband, declares Jehovah.

Isaiah 42:6

I am Jehovah; I have called You in righteousness; / I have held You by the hand; / I have kept You and I have given You / As a covenant for the people, as a light for the nations.

III. The enactment of the new covenant *Matthew 26:27-28*

²⁷And He took a cup and gave thanks, and He gave it to them, saying, Drink of it, all of you, ²⁸for this is My blood of the covenant, which is being poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.

Luke 22:20b

...This cup is the new covenant established in My blood, which is being poured out for you.

IV. The contents of the new covenant *Hebrews 8:10-12*

^{10a}For this is the covenant which I will covenant with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will impart My laws into their mind, and on their hearts I will inscribe them:

^{10b}and I will be God to them, and they will be a people to Me.

¹¹And they shall by no means each teach his fellow citizen and each his brother, saying, Know the Lord; for all will know Me from the little one to the great one among them.

¹²For I will be propitious to their unrighteousnesses, and their sins I shall by no means remember anymore.

Romans 8:2, 6 ²For the law of the Spirit of life has freed me in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and of death... ⁶For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the spirit is life and peace.

2 Corinthians 3:3 Since you are being manifested that you are a letter of Christ ministered by us, inscribed not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tablets of stone but in tablets of hearts of flesh.
