The Enactment of the Covenant and the New Covenant

I. The enactment of the covenant

Exodus 24:3-8

³And Moses came and told the people all the words of Jehovah and all the ordinances; and all the people answered with one voice and said, All the words which Jehovah has spoken we will do. ⁴And Moses wrote down all the words of Jehovah. And he rose up early in the morning and built an altar at the base of the mountain and twelve pillars for the twelve tribes of Israel. ⁵And he sent young men of the children of Israel, who offered burnt offerings and sacrificed peace offerings of bulls to Jehovah. ⁶And Moses took half of the blood and put it in basins, and half of the blood he sprinkled on the altar. ⁷And he took the book of the covenant and read it in the hearing of the people; and they said, All that Jehovah has spoken we will do, and we will be obedient. ⁸So Moses took the blood and sprinkled it on the people and said, Here is the blood of the covenant, which Jehovah has made with you in accordance with all these words.

II. The new covenant

Jeremiah 31:31-32

³¹Indeed, days are coming, declares Jehovah, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah, ³²Not like the covenant which I made with their fathers in the day I took them by their hand to bring them out from the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, although I was their Husband, declares Jehovah.

Isaiah 42:6

I am Jehovah; I have called You in righteousness; / I have held You by the hand; / I have kept You and I have given You / As a covenant for the people, as a light for the nations.

III. The enactment of the new covenant

Matthew 26:27-28

²⁷And He took a cup and gave thanks, and He gave it to them, saying, Drink of it, all of you, ²⁸for this is My blood of the covenant, which is being poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.

Luke 22:20b

...This cup is the new covenant established in My blood, which is being poured out for you.

IV. The contents of the new covenant

Hebrews 8:10-12

^{10a}For this is the covenant which I will covenant with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will impart My laws into their mind, and on their hearts I will inscribe them;

^{10b}and I will be God to them, and they will be a people to Me.

¹¹And they shall by no means each teach his fellow citizen and each his brother, saying, Know the Lord; for all will know Me from the little one to the great one among them.

¹²For I will be propitious to their unrighteousnesses, and their sins I shall by no means remember anymore.

Romans 8:2, 6 ²For the law of the Spirit of life has freed me in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and of death...⁶For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the spirit is life and peace.

2 Corinthians 3:3 Since you are being manifested that you are a letter of Christ ministered by us, inscribed not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tablets of stone but in tablets of hearts of flesh.

1 John 2:27 And as for you, the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you have no need that anyone teach you; but as His anointing teaches you concerning all things and is true and is not a lie...
