The Vision of God's Building

Genesis 28:12, 16-22 [Jacob] dreamed that there was a ladder set up on the earth, and its top reached to heaven; and there the angels of God were ascending and descending on it. [16] And Jacob awoke from his sleep and said, Surely Jehovah is in this place, and I did not know *it*. [17] And he was afraid and said, How awesome is this place! This is none other than the house of God, and this is the gate of heaven. [18] And Jacob rose up early in the morning and took the stone that he had put under his head, and he set it up as a pillar and poured oil on top of it. [19] And he called the name of that place Bethel... [20] And Jacob vowed a vow saying..., [22] This stone, which I have set up as a pillar, will be God's house...

Isaiah 66:1 Thus says Jehovah, / **Heaven** is My throne, /And the **earth** the footstool for My feet. / Where then is **the house that you will build for Me**, / And where is **the place of My rest**?

Psalm 132:1-5 How [David] swore to Jehovah / And vowed to the Mighty One of Jacob: [3] I shall not go into the tent of my house; / I shall not go up onto the couch of my bed; [4] I shall not give sleep to my eyes, / Slumber to my eyelids; [5] Until I find a place for Jehovah, / A tabernacle for the Mighty One of Jacob.

2 Samuel 7:5, 11-14 Go and say to My servant David, Thus says Jehovah, Is it you who will **build Me a house for Me to dwell in**? [11] ...Moreover Jehovah declares to you that Jehovah will make you a house. [12] When your days are fulfilled and you sleep with your fathers, I will raise up your seed after you, which will come forth from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. [13] It is he who will build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. [14] I will be his Father, and he will be My son...

Matthew 16:16, 18-19 Simon Peter answered and said, You are the Christ, the Son of the living God. [18] And I also say to you that you are Peter [a stone], and upon this rock <u>I will build My church</u>, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. [19] I will give to you the keys of the kingdom of the heavens, and whatever you bind on the earth shall have been bound in the heavens, and whatever you loose on the earth shall have been loosed in the heavens.

1 Peter 2:4-5 Coming to Him, a living stone, rejected by men but with God chosen and precious, [5] you yourselves also, as living stones, are being built up as a spiritual house into a holy priesthood to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

Revelation 21:2-3, 11 I saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. [3] And I heard a loud voice out of the throne, saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will tabernacle with them, and they will be His peoples, and God Himself will be with them and be their God. [11] ... Her light was like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, as clear as crystal.
