### 1. Take the Helmet of Salvation

- i. What is the main purpose of a helmet?
- ii. Why did Paul give this a new command and not just include it as modifying the original command of standing firm? What is the importance of separating it?
- iii. What are some practical ways that help you to remember to take up your helmet daily?

### 2. Understand the Helmet of Salvation

- i. How should your life be affected by knowing and meditating on your future salvation or glorification?
  - i. Consider reading **Romans 8:28-38** in your group
  - ii. Because we know who our opponent is from last week's study, what are the things that Satan uses to tempt us?
  - iii. Why do you think that Satan is so focused on fighting with or sending demons to contend with believers?
    - i. Consider reading **Ephesians 2:1-3**

- ii. *Focus on the fact through God's grace and mercy in Christ Jesus crucified, buried and resurrected, we were taken from his domain of darkness into the domain of Christ*

### 3. Use the Helmet of Salvation

- i. How do we make sure that we are using the helmet of salvation in our lives?
- ii. Do you find yourself struggling with walking into battle without donning your helmet? If so, why? Can you think of specific reasons why?
- iii. Read **2 Peter 1:3-8**. How does this passage encourage you in the daily trials you encounter?
- iv. Read **1 Thessalonians 5:8-9**. How can you apply this passage to your life? Do you dwell on the hope of salvation that is mentioned in this text?
