1 Corinthians 6:7–8 (NASB95):

7 Actually, then, it is already a defeat for you, that you have lawsuits with one another. Why not rather be wronged? Why not rather be defrauded?

8 On the contrary, you yourselves wrong and defraud. You do this even to your brethren.

Questions

1. DON'T BRING YOUR LAWSUITS TO UNBELIEVERS

- i. What is the harm in having unbelievers judge matters of the church?
- ii. How have you been tempted to allow the judgment of unbelievers affect how you make decisions?
- iii. What are the effects of using the worlds wisdom to direct your spiritual life?

2. IT IS BETTER TO BE WRONGED

- i. Have you ever been wronged? If so, how did you FEEL and how did you RESPOND?
- ii. Is there anything wrong with being wronged?
- iii. How do you equip yourself to respond to being wronged? What truths do you memorize or remember?

3. IT IS BETTER TO BE DEFRAUDED

i. Have you ever been cheated or robbed of something?



- ii. What are ways that we cheat or rob the church today, outside of lawsuits?
- iii. What should our perspectives be when we are cheated, robbed or deprived so something?

4. DON'T ACT LIKE A PAGAN BEFORE PAGANS

- i. Is there anything in your life that would make you look like a pagan to the unbelieving world?
- ii. With all the truth you have been equipped with, taught, and encouraged in, how do you fight daily to live like a Christian?
- iii. What does it mean, practically, to live like Christ? Is that a daily, weekly, monthly thing? Is that a momentary thing?
