Bible Passage

" ⁷ For you yourselves know how you ought to imitate us, because we did not act in an unruly manner among you, ⁸ nor did we eat anyone's bread without paying for it, but with labor and hardship we *kept* working night and day so that we would not be a burden to any of you;"

Discussion Questions

I. Imitate Paul's model... (v. 7a)

- a. What are some reasons why our culture opposes imitation?
- b. How can we imitate a person while also trying to imitate Christ?
- c. What dangers might you encounter if you try to do things your own way?
- d. What are some of the benefits of learning by imitation?
- e. Will imitation always be conscious and intentional? How should this affect who you spend your time with? How should we choose who to imitate?

II. ... because his model isn't harmful (v. 7b-8a)

- a. What are specific ways we can practice imitating our leaders? 1 Tim 4:12
- b. Why is attention to detail important as we progress in sanctification?
- c. What are some situations where a person might feel tempted to mooch off someone else? How are these examples of theft in the heart?
- d. What are some digital or electronic temptations to taking without paying? Why do these matter, even though we might think nobody is watching or "getting hurt"?

III. ... because his model **is helpful** (v. 8b)

- a. What are some ways that God has been generous toward you?
- b. How have you been served and blessed by Anchor Bible Church?
- c. What other motivations should encourage our diligent labor? Eph 4:28, 1 Th 4:12
- d. How can you cultivate a lifestyle of selfless sacrifice and eager generosity?
- e. What are other ways you can aim to be a blessing instead of a burden?
- f. How does more time with someone help you imitate them better?
