Paul's Pastoral Request and Blessing

2 Thessalonians 3:1-5 (NASB95):

- **1** Finally, brethren, pray for us that the word of the Lord will spread rapidly and be glorified, just as *it did* also with you;
- 2 and that we will be rescued from perverse and evil men; for not all have faith.
- **3** But the Lord is faithful, and He will strengthen and protect you from the evil one.
- **4** We have confidence in the Lord concerning you, that you are doing and will *continue* to do what we command.
- **5** May the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the steadfastness of Christ.

Summary of the passage, from The New Treasury of Scripture Knowledge:

"The apostle requests the prayers of the Thessalonians, especially for the success of his ministry; expresses his confidence respecting them; and prays for them, 1-5."

I. Paul's Desire: for the Word of the Lord

➤ How does it instruct us that the *Apostle Paul* is requesting prayer from the Thessalonians (themselves being far less experienced in grace than he. . .)?



- What does this say about how Paul viewed the success/failure of his ministry?
- In what way(s) is the progress of the "word of the Lord" (i.e. the gospel)
 dependent upon prayer?
- Why is it important for us to know that "not all have faith"?
- What examples do we see today of wicked people seeking to hinder the spread of the gospel?
- How can we be praying for gospel ministry in the world today?
- ➤ What areas of your life/ministry are you tempted to elevate *ability* over *prayer*? Are you tempted to depend upon your own skills/talents/efforts rather than on the Lord through prayer?

II. Paul's Trust: the Faithfulness of the Lord

- ➤ What are some specific things that Scripture teaches God is faithful to do?
- ➤ How has God proven Himself faithful in **your** life?
- > Knowing that God is faithful, how should that **change/impact** us?

III. Paul's Confidence: in the Lord



- ➤ Even though God is the faithful One, what do we learn about the Thessalonians' behavior from verse 4?
- ➤ If God is sovereign, how important is our obedience?
- ➤ Paul encourages the Thessalonians by speaking highly of their dedication to obey God's Word. How can we encourage one another in a similar way? Is it important to encourage one another?

IV. Paul's Blessing: Growth from the Lord

- ➤ How does a knowledge of God's love lead to steadfastness? What does it mean to be steadfast?
- ➤ Have you noticed that you are growing in steadfastness since you became a Christian?
- ➤ In what ways does the Lord "direct our hearts" into the steadfastness of Christ?

Prayer Topics:

- > Pray that God will direct us and grow us into a mature faith and into the steadfastness of Christ.
- > Pray for protection and fruitfulness for those involved in teaching/preaching the Word of God at ABC and across the world.
