REWIND questions

4. How does a person inherit eternal life? v. 18

5. What was the barrier that kept the young man from having eternal life? v. 22 and what one thing keeps you from "following" Jesus? (Matt 4:19)
6. Discuss this quote as related to the message. "Those who do not enter the kingdom as a home are those who are unwilling to leave themselves."
7. What goes through your head and heart when you think of the gospel?
8. When did "you" give your life to Jesus Christ by actually believing the gospel? (Mark 1:15)
