Spiritual Warfare

The Armor of God

Ephesians 6:10-18 (NASB)

"Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might. Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore, take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm. Stand firm therefore, having girded your loins with truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; in addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints."

The Spiritual Realms

- 1. Christianity is not just ideas such as theology & cognitive content!
- 2. Christianity is not just emotions such as spiritual experiences!

- 3. Christianity is not just inward existential depth and mysticism!
- 4. Christianity is not just social and cultural rituals and traditions!
- 5. Christianity is not just behavioral, full of morals and good works.
- 6. Christianity involves an active participation in the Spiritual Realms which are real places filled with real actual spiritual beings and real actual spiritual forces:
 - God, angels, archangels, cherubim, seraphim, demons, powers, principalities, thrones, dominions, just men made perfect, blessings, curses, prophecies, altars, temples, Heavenly Watchers, Beasts, the First, Second and Third Heavens, the Pit, the Lake of Fire and so on.... see Isaiah 6:1-7 and Daniel 7:9,10 as examples)

Jesus & The Spiritual Universe

- 1. 12 legions of angels at His command (Matthew 26:53)
- 2. His life a fulfillment of prophetic Scriptures (Matthew 26:54)
- 3. God is the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob who are still living and resurrection is a reality (Matthew 22:29-32)
- 4. Is transfigured and talks with Moses and Elijah (Matt 17:1-8)
- 5. At Jesus' baptism by a prophet Heaven is opened, God speaks, the Holy Spirit descends as a dove (Matthew 13:13-17)
- 6. A special star portends His birth and he is born in a Bethlehem as a fulfillment of prophecy, and God appears in dreams to the wise men, Joseph etc. (Matthew 2:1-12)

7. Jesus is driven into the wilderness by the Holy Spirit, and is tempted by the Devil, to do things such as turning stones into bread and angels minister to Him (Matthew 4:1-11)

The Great Separation

- 1. In Genesis 1 & 2 everything was good. Heaven and Earth were in harmony and the Garden of Eden contained spiritual properties. Then Adam and Eve sinned and we lost access to heavenly things. A great curse was placed over mankind and the earth. Eventually this age was brought to an end by the Flood.
- 2. Since then God has slowly been reuniting Heaven and earth, through Abraham, through Israel and the Temple, through the incarnate and victorious Christ, through the Church, through the outpoured Holy Spirit and the gifts and in the end God's dwelling place will be with men in a new, reunited Heaven and earth and all evil will be removed.

The Kosmos (World)

- 1. The kosmos is the ancient astrological (evil) heavens and the world in rebellion against God, the Devil's earth without Heaven. When Jesus announced the "Kingdom of Heaven is at hand" he was announcing the end of the kosmos and its tyranny over men and his healing miracles proved this.
- The Devil's kosmos is "passing away' along with the lusts thereof. The Devil controls it and even offered it to Jesus (Luke 4:1-13). The Great Commission is destroying the kosmos and eventually it will reach the point where Satan is cast out.
- 3. Satan deceives the kings of the earth by promising them exalted positions in the kosmos (Masonry etc) and he is

assisted by earth-dwellers (people who love the earth without heaven and wish to sin and worship idols)

Christians and The Spiritual Universe

Pentecost baptizes us into the spiritual world:

Acts 2:16-18 (NASB)

- "16 but this is what was spoken of through the prophet Joel: 17 And it shall be in the last days,' God says, 'That I will pour forth of My Spirit on all mankind; And your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, And your old men shall dream dreams; 18 Even on My bondslaves, both men and women, I will in those days pour forth of My Spirit And they shall prophesy."
- As participants in Heaven we are to leave the kosmos and its evil order behind us: 2 Corinthians 6:14-18, 1 John 2:15-17The Heavenly Zion

Hebrews 12:18-24 (NASB)

"18 For you have not come to a mountain that can be touched and to a blazing fire, and to darkness and gloom and whirlwind, 19 and to the last of a trumpet and the sound of words which sound was such that those who heard begged that no further word be spoken to them. 20 For they could not bear the command, "If even a beast touches the mountain,

it will be stoned." 21 And so terrible was the sight, that Moses said, "I am full of fear and trembling." 22 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to myriads of angels, 23 to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God, the Judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect, 24 and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood, which speaks better than the blood of Abel."

Faith In The Invisible (Hebrews 11)

- Faith involves an understanding of the spiritual and invisible realm that creates forms and undergirds this Universe and its operation. (Hebrews 11:1-3)
- Faith believes that God the Creator is in charge and that He rewards those who seek Him. (Hebrews 11:6)
- Faith enables mystery, adventure and impossibility (v 4-22)
- Faith seeks the "City that is to come, a heavenly city" (v. 16)
- Faith sees, believes and relies on the invisible realm for tangible solutions to real world problems (v. 23-34)

The Throne of God

- The central reality in every major vision of Heaven is the Throne of God!: Revelation chapters 4 & 5, 20:11-15 and Daniel 7:1-14
- This throne controls the Heavens and the Earth and the entire natural and supernatural order: Genesis 1, Colossians 1:15-20, Hebrews 1:1-3, John 1:1-3
- The gospel of the Almighty Creator God: Revelation 14:6,7

• Read Jonah chapter 1 and look for God's throne-room control of earthly events both natural and supernatural!

The Throne of Satan

- Satan had a "throne" the pagan altar to Zeus in Pergamum, which has now been rebuilt in Berlin.
- Satan's throne is on earth! In a building made with human hands!
- God does not dwell in buildings made by human hands (1 Kings 8:27, Isaiah 66:1, Acts 7:48, 17:24, 25, 2 Corinthians 5:1)
- Satan's power is tiny compared with the power of God Almighty
- Satan controls human systems simply through human weakness and sin and through deception.





Three Main Types of Demons

- Those in the "air" and the spiritual realms. Ephesians 2:1-4, 6:12, Rev 9:20, 12:1-9, 16:14, John 10:10 Cultural, religious and territorial influence, idolatry, cults, resist the gospel, deceive the kings of the earth, create wars, create rebellion, instigate crime and disobedience.
- Those that occupy human bodies.
 Mark 5:1-17, Acts 16:16-18
 Personal and minor regional influence. Madness, disease, occult prediction, some criminal acts
- 3. Those chained in darkness under the Earth. Jude 1:6, 2 Peter 2:4, Revelation 9:1-12, 11:7, 17:8 Archetypes, ruled the ancient world, founded the world religions and ancient myths and legends. Ancient spirits in rebellion, now judged, but may be released for a brief period during the Tribulation when the Pit is opened and Abbadon/ Apollyon is released.

The Three Big Battles

- 1. The Battle For Israel (to prevent the birth of the Messiah) as recorded in the Old Testament and the Gospels esp. Matthew.
- 2. The Battle For The Church, the body of Christ. The war against the saints. Aims to delay the return of Christ who will return with all His "holy ones", this is the battle to prevent the salvation of the lost, the maturing of Christians and the perfection of the Church in all nations. This is recorded in the Gospels, Acts and the Epistles.

3. The Battle for Final World Dominion and Government, Satan tries to hold on to earth but He knows that his time is short, persecutes the Church, takes over all structures of human government and puts up a last-ditch stand at Armageddon. This is mainly recorded in Revelation, Daniel, Ezekiel and other prophetic literature.

The Victory Of Faith

1 John 5:1-5 (NASB)

"Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and whoever loves the Father loves the child born of Him. By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and observe His commandments. For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments; and His commandments are not burdensome. For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world-our faith. Who is the one who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?"

The Victorious Mind

For those who are according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who are according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the Spirit is life and peace."

The Overcomer

1 John 4:4 (NASB): "You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world."

Revelation 12:10-11 (NASB): "Then I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, "Now the salvation, and the power, and the kingdom of our God and the authority of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren has been thrown down, he who accuses them before our God day and night. And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced with death."

Global challenges to the global Church in the midst of uncertain world: Part 1

I would like to express my deepest gratitude to the Lord and to you for your interest in this issue. The Church has been taking the wrong road for some time and we must stop and shed light into what the issues are that has weakened the church the gospel presentation that lost people around the world desperately need.

By going through these notes, I want to let you know that I am not here to judge the Church, it is the Lord's Church. I am just shedding light into what's been happening in the global church based on my experience in 46 countries equipping pastors, church leaders, missionaries, and laypeople.

Two kind of Christianity

We must understand that there are two kinds of Christianity in the world:

1. Cultural Christianity.

2. Biblical Church.

Majority of the global church leaders do not put much emphasis on teaching their members Biblical Doctrines.

- Doctrine sometimes is despised. Some say, it's too rigid, no room for a second option. My answer is, **that's right**.
- Biblical doctrine is God's instructions, **period**. There is no room for negotiation.
- Some say, having this kind of thinking, is legalistic. Even though they cannot define what legalism means?
- Some say, having this thinking is dogmatic. Well, being dogmatic on biblical truths is a great thing.

In previous generations, Church leaders left a legacy of biblical expository preaching with emphasis on:

- The return of the Lord Jesus Christ
- Heaven (our eternal home with Him).
- Salvation
- Sin
- Hell
- And Christ like living.

The Church today is leaving the next generation, not expository preaching, but relational preaching.

• No emphasis on Heaven (eternal life with Christ), but emphasis on the here and now. In the past, believers grew up listening to the true gospel and the consequences of Sin, now the church is focused on public relations, health, wealth, fundraising, and personal happiness.

As a result, modern day Christianity and its Churches has been working on undermining the true Church and the message of the Cross.

THE BIBLE

The Bible has been under attack for centuries, but the intensity of the attack we have seen on the Bible within the last 40 years is unprecedented. Here are some issues:

- The Bible is **not** the ONLY inspired Word of God.
- Misunderstanding what the doctrine of **Revelation** of Scripture is? What is Revelation?
- Is the book of Revelation considered the FINAL revelation from God to man? Or does God still revealing new Scripture? How does God speak to us today?

This has been the most dangerous attack on the Bible thus far. If the Bible is not complete, then the Bible is not the final authority in the Church. If God speaks outside the Scripture, then how do we know what is true what is not?

- How can we measure when someone said: "God told me" Is it from God?
- This brings us to the doctrine of **Inspiration**. What did God inspire? The prophets and Apostles? Or the writings?
 - 2 Timothy 3:16. We have this statement about the inspiration of the Bible it says: "all scripture is given by inspiration of God."
 - There are three words in the Greek text of this verse.
 - Is the word all or every, Simple Greek word, *all or every*.
 - The second word is *Graphi* from which we get graphic arts meaning, writing. Every *writing*.
 - The third word is a compound word of the word **God** and the Word to **breathed**. You will translate it, every writing **God-breathed** a compound word **God– breathed**. That's exactly what it is, *every writing God-breathed*, that's a literal interpretation or translation.
 - "I tell you the truth, until heaven and earth disappear, not the smallest letter, not the least stroke of a pen, will by any means disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished." — Matthew 5:18

THE DOCTRINE OF GOD

The identity of God has been attacked

- Some missionaries that work in an Islamic context, equate Yahweh with Allah. They have also exported this thinking to most churches in the Muslim world.
- Some denominations deny the **Triunity**
- In the Word of faith movement, they have elevated Man and demoted God with the **little God** doctrine. Here are some examples:
 - <u>Crreflo Dollar Teaches We Are Little Gods</u>
 - Joyce Meyer- Little Gods
- The prosperity gospel preachers have made God similar to the Genie in a bottle.
- Thus, God is no longer feared and honored.

THE DOCTRINE OF JESUS CHRIST

We expect other world religions to defame or mis-categorize the Lord Jesus Christ. But for the church to do so? that is blasphemy.

- Some missionaries in the Muslim world equate the Lord Jesus of the Bible with Isa (Jesus of the Qur'an).
- The word of faith movement made Jesus lessor that the ONLY SON of GOD.
- Preaching the wrong Jesus, Jesus that is a fixer and Santa Clause.

- Preaching Jesus as a Redeemer, but not a righteous Judge.
- Some even hanging on to the O.T. feasts and sacrifices along side of Jesus. They ignored that Jesus is the fulfillment of all O.T. sacrifices and feasts. (The church that is going back to its Jewish roots).
- Ignoring Jesus warning to the church in Ephesus: "4 Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love. 5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.. " Rev. 2:4-5. (KJV)

The Doctrine of Salvation

Many churches around the world have not hold on to the biblical teaching of Salvation according to Scripture:

"8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast. 10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them. Ephesians 2:8 (KJV)

- Many Christians have not been taught that Salvation is free, not by works.
- Many Christians live under the heavy burden that they have to maintain their salvation through good works.

• The Lord allowed me to help free many around the world and explain the misinterpretation of what James and Paul have said.

"17 Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. 18 Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works." (James 2:17-18) (KJV).

- However, James has already emphasized that salvation is God's gracious gift (1:17–18), and in verse 23 he quotes Genesis 15:6, which declares that God imputed righteousness to Abraham solely on the basis of his faith.
- James' teaching, then, that Abraham's willingness to offer Isaac vindicates his faith before men—a teaching with which the Apostle Paul was in total agreement (Eph. 2:10). There is thus no conflict between the two inspired writings in Ephesians and James.

The Doctrine of the Security of the Believer

Due to the lack of sound biblical teaching, I would venture and say thousands of Christians think that they would lose their salvation if they did not keep up their good works. Not sure where they got this understanding, but I am sure there are many reasons behind it.

Some say, well that's a baptist thing: "once saved always saved."

The security of salvation of the believer, is not a baptist doctrine, but a biblical doctrine. Our salvation is secure in the completed work of Christ on the Cross.

Ephesians 1:4-14 (KJV)

"4 According as he hath **chosen** us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: 5 Having predestinated us unto the **adoption of children** by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, 6 To the praise of the glory of His grace, wherein He hath made us accepted in the beloved. 7 In whom we have **redemption** through His blood, the **forgiveness** of sins, according to the riches of His grace; 8 Wherein He hath abounded toward us in all wisdom and prudence; 9 Having made known unto us the mystery of His will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in Himself: 10 That in the dispensation of the fulness of times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in Him: 11 In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of Him who worketh all things after the counsel of His own will: 12 That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ. 13 In whom ye also **trusted**, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were **sealed** with that Holy Spirit of **promise**, 14 Which is the **earnest** of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of His glory.

We see from this passage that the Triune God Almighty been involved in our salvation. The Father: v4. "**chose us** before the foundation of the world" The Lord Jesus provided a way: vs. 7. "the **redemption** through His blood," and the Holy Spirit resides in us: vs.13 "ye were **sealed** with that Holy Spirit of **promise**."

- The Father Chose us
- The Son redeemed us
- The Holy Spirit sealed us

There are many other passages that helps us know that our salvation is not secured in our works, but in Christ's finished work on the Cross. But, would like to look at Romans 8:31-39

31 What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? **32** He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? 33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. 34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us. **35** Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36 As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. **37** Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. 38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, **39** Nor height, nor depth, nor any other

creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

This passage says it all. Basically, neither God the Father nor the Son would change their mind about our salvation. Also, Satan doesn't have the power to take our salvation away from us nor separates us from the love of Christ. Then, not even life circumstances would be able to separate us from the Love of Christ. Nor any other creature that God has created would be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

This goes back to vs.31: "*If God is for us, who can be against us?*" No one is more powerful than God, thus our salvation is secured in His hands.

The doctrine of Sin

The doctrine of Sin has been minimized in modern day churches. Meaning, sin is not preached as an offense to God. Resulting in eternal damnation in the Lake of Fire.

What is sin?

- Sin is breaking the Law of God. 1 John 3:4b says, "for sin is the transgression of the law." Sin is a transgression, an iniquity, an unrighteous act.
- Sin is a deviation from the will of God.
- It is a form of evildoing since it is in opposition to God's decrees and desires.
- Sin is not a merely a deficiency. It is an open rebellion and disobedience to what God has declared is right.

The question is why? Many reasons:

 It goes back to man's the view of God. Many have adopted the view of God is only loving, compassionate, merciful, good God. All of which are true, but many intentionally ignore the righteousness, holiness, and justice of God. God's holiness and righteousness demand justice. There is penalty for sin, if it is not dealt with. The only way to deal with it is by trusting and surrendering our lives to the Lord Jesus Christ and accepting what He has done on the cross as a substitutionary payment to satisfy God's requirement or penalty for our sins.

Here are some verses:

- "Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:" Rom. 5:12
- "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;" Rom. 3:23
- "25 Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;" Rom. 3:25
- "28Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law." Rom. 3:28
- "8 For **by grace** are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 **Not of works**, lest any man should boast.10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them." Eph. 2:8-10

- 2. Man's view of man. In modern Christianity, man has been elevated, in some denominations or occult's teaching, Jesus is now lower than man. Thus, man's need for Jesus' redemption becomes secondary to Man's ability to earn his way to heaven. When Man is elevated, Jesus became servant of Man. Then, Man is good in his nature.
 - "4 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; 2 Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;" 1 Timothy 4:1-2.
 - Man's heart are deceitful and desperately wicked (Jer. 17:9).
 - Man is full of evil (Mark 7:21-23).
 - Man loves darkness rather than light (John 3:19).
 - Man is unrighteous, do not understand, do not seek God (Rom. 3:10-12).
 - Man is helpless and ungodly (Rom. 5:6).
 - Man is dead in his trespasses and sins (Eph. 2:1).
 - Man is by nature a child of wrath (Eph. 2:3).
 - Man cannot understand spiritual things (1 Cor. 2:14).

But, thanks be to God and His redemption in Christ, we are new creatures:

2 Cor. 5:17: 17: "<u>Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a</u> <u>new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things</u> <u>are become new</u>."

Because of the indwelling Spirit of God, we are able to understand spiritual things, seek God, and are no longer ungodly. This is the benefit of God's redemptive work in us. Therefore, though we were dead in our sins, we are alive in Christ.

The Doctrine of Hell

There are some Christian groups and many cults that deny the idea the existence of hell. Or the idea that in the general sense, means *eternal, conscious punishment*. Some would argue that hell is temporary, but ultimately a person would end up in heaven. By having this view of hell, this will make the doctrine of sin as nothing to pay attention to. Nor, the doctrine of God and His justice.

Perhaps the most common objection to the doctrine of hell is that a loving God would never punish people in eternal torment.

- We agree that God is love (1 John 4:8)
- But He is also just (Neh. 9:32-33; 2 Thess. 1:6)
- He is eternal (Psalm 90:2; 1 Tim. 1:17).
- God punishes the evildoer (Isaiah 11:13), and this punishment will be eternal.

But the question remains, is this eternal conscious punishment or not?

- The wicked descend alive into Sheol. Numbers 16:30
- Cast to outer darkness with weeping and gnashing of teeth. Matt. 8:12.
- Those cast into the fire suffer consciously. Matt. 13: 41-42
- Cast into a tormenting fire. Rev. 14: 9-11.
- Thrown into the lake of Fire. Rev. 20:10.
- Unquenchable Fire. Matt. 3:12
- Fiery Hell. Matt. 5:22; Matt. 5:29, 30.
- Eternal Fire. Matt. 25:41; Jude 7.

- Eternal Punishment. Matt 25:46
- Lake of Fire. Rev 20:15.

Therefore, Hell is a **REAL** place. It is not mere unconsciousness. It is not temporal. It is **eternal** torment. Perhaps that is why the Lord Jesus spoke more of hell than heaven and spent so much time warning people not to go there.

Praise God for His free eternal gift of salvation in His Son's sacrifice on the Cross paying the penalty on our behalf.

The Doctrine of the Church

Modern Christianity has distorted the purpose and the role of the Church "The body of Christ." It has been centralized and confined into a building. Thus the bigger or more popular is the better. However, the role and purpose of the church being redefined.

How does it manifest itself:

- The church has become an inward self-centered organization. The reason I call it an organization, because it has taken its model from the cooperate world. Success of the church became the focus of its leaders to have more members (Numbers) not necessarily by salvation. but, membership increase.
- The church's preaching changed from expository to topical and self-motivational sermons.

- The church became the platform for saving souls. That means, bring the lost to the church and they will get saved. Thus, resulted in a seeker sensitive services.
- Study books written by men, such as purpose driven life.

Results

- Shallow preaching that resulted in shallow faith and living.
- Members easily being mislead due to their ignorance of the Bible.
- Lack of seeking God's face, it's all about what God can do for me.
- Gave birth to: Seeker sensitive and Emergant movements. These birthed other heretical movements.
- Gave platform to false teachers that have no accountability nor being called out by the true church.

What is church?

The church can be understood in two ways: *the visible and the invisible*.

The **visible** church is comprised of all who claim to be a Christian and who gather together for worship and participate in the Lord's Supper and believer's Baptism by emersion. However, the visible church **also comprised** of people claim to be Christians, but not born again.

The members of the **invisible** church are the **actual** body of believers. They are the ones who are truly regenerate and have trusted, by faith, in the true Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ alone. The true Christian is indwelt by the the Holy Spirit. (John 14:23)

Therefore, the true Christian Church is said to be the body of Christ.

"5 So we, being many, are **one body** in Christ, and every one members one of another." Rom. 12:5

"12 For the **perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry**, for the edifying of the body of Christ:" Eph. 4:12.

It is interesting that from Eph. 4:12 is that the purpose of the church is "*perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry.*" That means that the church is a place for theological training and equipping, for the work of the ministry OUTSIDE the church building. In the market place.

What was the focus of the Apostles in Acts 2?

"41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls. 42 And they continued steadfastly in the **apostles' doctrine** and **fellowship**, and in **breaking of bread**, and in **prayers**."Acts 2:41-42 (KJV)

From this passage we see the church was focused on four essentials:

- 1. The Apostles' teaching (Scripture & Doctrine)
- 2. Fellowship
- 3. Breaking of bread
- 4. Prayer.

Praise & Worship

In the west, the emphasis during church service is the **praise and worship**. According to Acts 2:42, we don't see it as part of the four essentials. The typical time spent during the church service spent on singing at the cost of preaching and teaching the Word of God.

Bible teaching moved to the Sunday school classrooms, or small groups. The quality of such study, varies from one church to another. It reflect the DNA of that particular church. If the church is a seeker sensitive church, then the small group study would be very superficial. If the church's emphasis on biblical teaching, the small group's study is in depth study.

Unfortunately, there are more superficial/seeker sensitive or consumer driven churches than Bible driven church.

Prayer

Prayer is another essential that has been sacrificed, in most church services, prayer is in the beginning and the end of the service. Even though singing good theological songs is edifying to the Body of Christ. But, it should not replace sound biblical teaching/preaching and prayer.

The Bible speaks much of prayer.

- We need to bow our knees
- confess our sin
- Receive God's forgiveness
- Request that the will of the Lord be done above our own

God is sovereign and loving and He knows what is best for us and others, even if it doesn't always seem to make the most sense.

We need to memorize and take to heart the promises the Lord has given us in the Scripture. Such as:

"13 These things have I **written** unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may **know** that ye have eternal life, and that ye may **believe** on the name of the Son of God.

14 And this is the **confidence** that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing **according to His will**, He **heareth us**:

15 And if we **know** that He **hear us**, whatsoever we ask, we know that **we have** the petitions that we desired of Him." 1 John 5:13-15. (KJV)

From this passage, the Lord gives us a guideline to answered prayers:

- 1. To be a **child of God** through Christ redemptive work on the Cross.
- 2. Be in **God's will**.
- 3. Ask the Lord.
- 4. Keep asking.
- 5. Be assured that God has **heard** your requests.
- 6. Be assured that your requests has been **answered**.
- 7. Leave the **timing and method** to the Lord.

This western church model, has been exported globally. During my travels, this model is what I had encountered. Even though,

these churches has totally different cultural and traditional practices, and most of the pastors have no Biblical training to balance or counteract the western model.

Eschatology

Unfortunately, most denominational churches that I have been involved with in 45 countries, do not know much about the end times and the sequences of events that leads to the 2nd coming of Christ.

- The word eschatology comes from the Greek "eschatos" (last, or final) and "logos" (word).
- It is the study of the things that happen at the end of the age around the time of Jesus return (Matt. 24:3-14; Mark 13:4; 1 Thess. 5:2).

Topics included in the study of eschatology are:

- ➤ The return of Christ
- The rapture and whether or not it is before, during, or after the tribulation period.
- \sim The resurrection of the dead
- \sim The second coming of Christ
- \sim The Millennium Kingdom
- \sim The nation of Israel

➤ The two Judgments (Seat of Christ & Great White Throne) Eschatology tells us that we are to take comfort in the knowledge that Christ will return (1 Thess. 4:18) and we should be encouraged (1 Cor. 15:58), knowing that Christ will return.

The Rise of False Prophets and teachers

How they effect Bible translations

2 PETER 2:1-3

"But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction. And many shall follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of. And through covetousness shall they with feigned words make merchandise of you: whose judgment now of a long time lingereth not, and their damnation slumbereth not."

INTRODUCTION: 2 PETER 2:1-3

- Peter writes in the second and third chapters of his epistle about the unseen danger of false teachers who arise within the church.
- They are often unrecognized. Especially in their earliest forms, partly because they profess to share a "like precious faith."
- Yet, they secretly introduce false teaching, which is destructive to themselves and to all who follow them.

Five signs to identify false teachers & prophets

- 1. Self promotion
- 2. Popularity
- 3. Disobedience
- 4. Signs and Wonders
- 5. Materialism

WHAT WE NEED TO KNOW ABOUT FALSE TEACHERS (2 Pet. 2:1-3)

- 1. Peter strongly infers that we should regard anyone who claims to be a "prophet" as a false prophet.
- 2. Peter teaches us to expect false teachers to arise from within the church as well as from without.
- 3. The teaching of these false teachers is destructive to the church and to all who follow their teaching and practice.

- 4. False teachers bring reproach upon true saints and the church of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 5. These false teachers are not always evident.
- 6. False teachers can be identified by their morals and their motives:
 - Lusts
 - Greed (vs.3)
 - Selfishness
 - Exploiting others (vs.3)
 - Sensual not spiritual (vs.2)
- 7. False teachers can be recognized by their methods.
 - The "way of truth" is maligned (vs. 2-3).
 - Their doctrines are heresies, which are "destructive," (1:3).
 - They claim to teach the Word of God, but they actually twist and distort the Scriptures so their interpretations justify their lifestyle and their lusts.
- 8. These teachers go as far as to "deny the Master who bought them."
- 9. Just how do they deny Him? Peter seems to imply they deny His authority & those in authority. (2 Peter 2:10-11; Jude 8)
- 10. They actively seek to undermine those in authority and to establish their own authority.

HOW DO FALSE TEACHER ARISE?

- 1. They distort the emphasis of Scripture.
- 2. False teachers can deny the Lord Jesus by narrowing the field of affliction for which the cross of Christ provides the solution.

DEFINITION OF ISLAM

What is Islam?

- By definition, Islam is to SUBMIT to the entire system of the Islamic religion, its Tenets, and Laws.
- It does not mean PEACE.
- Islam derived from the word Istislam meaning (Submission or death).

True definition of Islam:

IT IS A SOCIO-POLITICAL SYSTEM THAT USES A DEITY TO ADVANCE ITS AGENDA

WHAT IS THE SPIRIT OF ISLAM?

- There is no spirit of truth in Islam as there is in the Gospel. (John 14:7; 15:26; 16:13)
- According to the Shari' a, lying is allowed in four cases:
 - Holy war
 - When two enemies have reconciled
 - By a man to his wives
 - By a wife to her husband
- This SPIRIT of DECEPTION and CUNNING comes into play especially when dealing with non-Muslims.
- We must learn to scrutinize the statements of Muslims, otherwise we will constantly be deceived. (1 Cor. 13:7); (Matt. 10:16)
- Islam is a post-Christian religion; and out of necessity has become an anti-Christian religion. (John 2:21-23; 1 John 4:1-4)

"Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. **Hereby** know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that **confesseth** that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God: And every spirit that **confesseth not** that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that **spirit of antichrist**, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world." 1 John 4:1-4

IF THE SPIRIT OF ISLAM IS AN ANTI-CHRIST SPIRIT, THEN ALL ISLAMIC TEACHINGS ARE ALSO ANTI-CHRIST TEACHINGS

The sufficiency of the Bible

The Bible is Sufficient for:

- Salvation
- Sanctification
- Evangelism
- Discipleship

How do false teachers effect Bible translations?

- When the Word of God is not the Supreme Authority, an **alternative** gospel message arises, insufficient to redeem mankind like the true Gospel.
- When traditions of Men **Nullify** Scripture, Christ alone is no longer sufficient

MIT: Muslim Idiom Translation

The rationale behind MIT can be found in David Owen's article, "A Jesus Movement Within Islam," under the subtitle, "A New Approach to Bible Translation":

"It is a necessary requirement that **Islamic-styled** Bible translations be produced in order for a Jesus movement in an Islamic context to ever get off the ground...Bible translators will play a foundational role in the initial stages of a Haraka Isawiyya [i.e. Jesus Movement]. In carrying out their task they will also take a consolidating step in the work of **retheologizing the Christian message** within their [i.e. Muslims'] particular context"

• Since 1987, some professing evangelicals began publishing Islamized "Scripture" which continues to this day.

- Islamic terms, including phrases from the Qur'an, are often used in place of key, biblical terms.
- This practice is part of C5 or Insider Movements for Muslims (C5/IM).
- C5/IM claims that a Muslim can retain a Muslim identity while having saving faith in Jesus Christ and result in a "Jesus Movement" within Islam.

How does MIT help Muslims?

- Muslims have claimed that Jews and Christians changed the Bible in order to reject Muhammad as the final prophet.
- MIT now gives Muslims "proof" that "Christians" have changed the Bible.

Distinguishing Features

MIT is normally characterized by any one or more of the following:

- Non-literal renderings for Father and Son terminology
- Words and phrases from the Qur'an
- Islamic theological terms
- The omission of certain passages

Representative (Mis) renderings

- Matthew 28:19: "the name of the Protector, his Representative and the Holy Spirit" (instead of "the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit")
- James 2:19: "there is no god but Allah" (instead of "God is one"). This is the first part of the shahada, or Islamic creed. There is no linguistic nor theological justification for this.
- Galatians 2:20: "caliph of God" (instead of "Son of God"). This makes Jesus a religious and political successor of Muhammad.

 Omissions: Luke 15; Rom 8:1-9, 12-33, 35-36, 38-39; Gal 4:1-7

How is Son of Man rendered?

- This phrase is usually not literally translated.
- This feature eliminates the divinely-inspired parallel between "Son of God" and "Son of Man."
- This parallel is an essential biblical witness that Jesus is both divine and human.
- Some representative verses to verify are: Matthew 12:8; Mark 14:62; Luke 22:48; John 3:13-14; Acts 7:56; Rev 1:13

False Doctrine

In Danger From False Brethren

In most of the occurrences in which 'Son of God' is used for Jesus, the usage is Messianic, meaning the focus is on Jesus' **role** as Lord and Savior. (Rick Brown-Wycliffe)

Bible facts about "Father" and "Son"

- "Father" in reference to God occurs 260x in the Greek New Testament*
- "Father" in reference to God is the same word used of human fathers
- "Son" in reference to Jesus occurs 79x in the Greek New Testament*
- "Son of God" in reference to Jesus occurs 45x in the Greek New Testament*
- "Son" in reference to Jesus is the same word used of human sons
- "Father" and "Son" are not treated as metaphors but as an integral witness to God's eternal Triune nature of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Matt 28:19)
- "Father" is the source for all family. "Father" thus cannot be an analogy (i.e. metaphor) with human fathers (Eph 3:14-15).

- "Son" / "Son of God" is called God (Isa 7:14; 9:6; Heb 1:8; 1 John 5:20), described as the Creator (Pr 30:4; Col 1:13, 16; Heb 1:2), and is stated to be eternal (Isa 9:6; Mic 5:2; Col 1:13, 17; Heb 7:3). "Son" / "Son of God" thus cannot be an analogy (i.e. metaphor) with human sons.
- "Father" and "Son" have enjoyed shared glory and love from eternity as "Father" and "Son" (John 17:5, 24)
- "Father" and "Son" is the basis for believers in Jesus becoming children or sons of God (e.g. John 1:12; Rom 8:14-19, 29; Gal 4:4-7; Eph 1:3-5; 1 John 3:1-2)

"Pay close attention to yourself and to your teaching; persevere in these things, for as you do this you will ensure salvation both for yourself and for those who hear you." 1 Tim. 4:16

Final Thoughts:

- Muslims ought not to be deprived of the Gospel in the name of Bible translation!
- Christians should not be defrauded of their time and money by praying and

funding something of which they would not approve!

- Christians should not be unwittingly distributing "Bible translations" that are anti- biblical!
- God should not be so impugned through the perversion of His Word! Proverbs 30:4-6; Jeremiah 8:8-9; 2 Corinthians 4:1-2; Revelation 22:18-19

Unbiblical Methods

Their reasoning:

- Yahweh = Allah
- Biblical Jesus = Islamic Jesus (Isa)
- There is truths in the Qur'an; thus we can share the gospel from it
- Muhammad is a true prophet

Their Practices:

- Missionaries call themselves Muslims
- Pray in the Mosque
- An Insider performs Salat (Prayer) in the Mosque, recites the Shahada (Islamic Confession of Faith).
- Fast the Month of Ramadan

- Telling Converts to call themselves Muslims followers of Isa (Islamic Jesus). Converts pray with Qur'an verses
- New converts remain in Mosque with no plan for withdrawal.
- The Insider can go to Hajj and participate in festivals and sacrifices.
- Christians can convert to Islam to join the Mosque.

Insider Movements

- One must ask, what happens when modern western philosophy, theology, social sciences, and linguistics converge in inherently syncretistic religious environments?
- IM is a by-product of the Emergent church, seeker sensitive, liberal seminaries, and political correctness in the church.
- Common Insider Beliefs

Common Insider Beliefs

- Mosque practice and Muslim celebrations are helpful and encouraged.
- Muhammad is a prophet of some kind, and in some cases he is equated to the Old Testament prophets.
- There are four sacred books; most think Qur'an is the greatest.
- Visible church is not necessary; it will bring attention and persecution, and it is a western thing.
- Son of God is equal to Isa al-Masih. (It is my conviction this by itself is blasphemy.)
- The Insider is considered to be a kind of fulfilled Muslim, not a kind of Christian; this is being equated with fulfilled Jews when they accept the Messiah.
- Insiders sometimes call themselves as messianic Muslims, similar to the messianic Jews.

- Does it describe a type of Muslim, a type of non-Muslim, or something else?
- Is culture neutral and can it be separated from religion?
- Forced isolation of insider community from observation and accountability
- Questionable math, lack of visible communities, significant attrition
- Prejudiced, selective, and inaccurate use of Scripture
- Continuing financial assistance for leaders
- Controversial translation work

Insider Issues

- Affirmation of Muhammad
- Terminology- Insider/outsider
- No role for the historical/traditional church
- No connections to the visible church
- Primacy of anthropology/sociology over theology
- Ethics issues concerned with deception
- Mosque influence: Salt & light?
- Confused identity
- A disregard for the plain reading and interpretation of the Bible, esp. the Gospels
- Dependence on extra-Biblical writings (i.e. non-inspired)
- Use of flawed premises and incorrect assertions about Scripture
- Accommodation to Muslim sentiment

Action points:

- When the essentials of faith are in question, we need to take time and respond.
- Our silence and inaction are part of several reasons as to why we are even having this discussion.

• Write letters to these and other organizations, including the missions boards of evangelical denominations



Leading to Rejection of God's authority

- 2. **Turn morality upside down** (substitute good for bad, light for darkness, bitter for sweet)
 - Heterosexuality is seen as the backbone that holds patriarchy together so is being consistently undermined.
 - This results in today's acceptance of homosexuality; destruction of male/female and family roles, and free sex with no boundaries.

What does it mean that Satan is the father of lies (John 8:44)?

Satan is the "father of lies" in that he is the original liar.

- After planting seeds of doubt in Eve's mind with a question (Genesis 3:1), he directly contradicts God's Word by telling her, "You will not certainly die" (Genesis 3:4).
- With that lie, Satan led Eve to her death; Adam followed, and so have we all.

Five lies Satan wants us to believe and how to overcome

1. God doesn't love you.

Sometimes it's hard to believe that God loves us. But God has told us in his word that he loves us.

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16 For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 8:38-39

- We don't always feel God's love for us. Especially when we're going through hard times.
- But our feelings, though true feelings, are not always the truth. And God has demonstrated His love for us by sending His Son to die for us while we were still sinners.
- Don't believe Satan's lie that God doesn't love you.
- Nothing can separate us from his love our failures, our lack of love for him, even our unbelief. God loves you.
- 2. God will not be faithful to you. He won't keep his promises. Satan tells us God won't meet our needs. God won't work in our lives. God won't save our children. But God promises in his word:

Deuteronomy 7:9; 1 Corinthians 1:8-9; 1 Cor. 10:13

- 3. God is not going to answer your prayers. Satan tells us God won't meet our needs. God won't work in our lives. God won't save our children.
 - Satan will point out situations where it looks like God didn't answer prayers.
 - He reminds us of people we prayed for who died.
 - He points out people we have prayed for to be saved who have not yet responded to the gospel. "God won't answer your prayers.
 - Don't bother praying for this."

Yet God tells us: James 5:16-18; Hebrews 11:6; Matthew 7:7-11

4. Nothing will happen to you if you sin Genesis 3:2-5

- Satan will tell us we can commit sin with no consequences.
- He will tell us we can commit sexual sin, or we can lie or steal or harbor unforgiveness.
- He will lie to us and tell us that to do something just once won't hurt anything.
- He will tell us no one will find out.
- Romans 6:23; Proverbs 11:29; James 1:14-15
- Every one of us has sinned and deserves death, both physical and eternal, yet God is so merciful, when we believe in Jesus, he delivers us out of spiritual death and gives us eternal life.
- Yet we don't want to believe Satan's lie that we can sin and suffer no consequences.
- When believers willfully sin, they often suffer horrible consequences.
- Marriages suffer, families suffer, churches suffer, individuals suffer.

5. Sin will satisfy you

- Sin would not be tempting if it didn't promise us pleasure or satisfaction. After Satan lied to her, Eve looked at the fruit on the tree and it looked promising.... Genesis 3:6
- Sin may "satisfy" us temporarily, but in the end it leaves us unsatisfied and unhappy. We must remember that the only one who can satisfy us is God: Psalm 16:5-6; Psalm 107:9; Psalm 103:5

• Only Jesus Christ can satisfy us. God fills us with his joy, peace and contentment. Sin can never satisfy. Don't believe Satan's lie that sin will satisfy us.

How to combat Satan's lies?


- Read God's Word, pray, and fellowship with the Lord. Ephesians 6:16-18 Counter Satan's lies with God's word, the shield of faith and sword of the Spirit. When Satan tempted Jesus, he countered with God's word, "It is written..."
- Realize there is a tempter out to destroy you "Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour." 1 Peter 5:8
- 3. Fear the Lord
 - "Be not wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD, and turn away from evil." Proverbs 3:7
 - "And he said to man, 'Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom, and to turn away from evil is understanding." Job 28:28

4. Flee temptation


- "Flee from sexual immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body." 1 Corinthians 6:18
