Expectation is defined as "believing that something is going to happen or believing that something should be a certain way".

What Expectations do you have of God?

Have you felt like Zacchaeus?

- (Tax collector or pure)
- Jesus Called him by name: Zacchaeus = "pure"

Jesus Invited Himself to his House

- Zacchaeus Received Jesus joyfully

What are your expectations for who can be saved?

Parable = cast alongside

- Jesus' parables were stories that were "cast alongside" a truth in order to illustrate that truth.
 - The Nobleman = Jesus
 - The Servants = Believers
 - The Citizens = those that reject Jesus
 - The mina = salvation
