Questions

- 4. What made Jesus approach (v. 13) to the leper "different" than what the Old Testament (Leviticus 13) states?
- 5. Erwin McManis says, "sometimes it takes an outsider who has been there on the outside, to see the circumstances of an outsider." Do you see people as Jesus sees?
- 6. Who are the lepers of our day that we tend to overlook?
- 7. How can we be sensitive to reach out and touch the lepers of our culture?
- 8. Why did Jesus tell the healed leper to go and show himself to the priest? (v. 14)
- 9. What was the impact of the healing on the community? (v. 15)
- 10. What was unique about Jesus in between ministry moments? (See 4:42 and 5:16). Describe how you do these verses.
