Big idea: *We've all got a little leprosy but we can all be healed.*

### Questions

1. Who are the contemporary "lepers" of our day?
2. What stands out the most to you about the leper? - v. 12
3. What do you make of Jesus touching the leper? - v. 13
4. What made Jesus approach (v. 13) to the leper "different" than what the Old Testament (Leviticus 13) states?
5. Erwin McManis says, "sometimes it takes an outsider who has been there on the outside, to see the circumstances of an outsider." Do you see people as Jesus sees?
6. Who are the lepers of our day that we tend to overlook?
7. How can we be sensitive to reach out and touch the lepers of our culture?
8. Why did Jesus tell the healed leper to go and show himself to the priest? (v. 14)
9. What was the impact of the healing on the community? (v. 15)
10. What was unique about Jesus in between ministry moments? (See 4:42 and 5:16). Describe how you do these verses.
