## Luke 20:1-18

The Chief priests ask Jesus where His authority comes from.

- Why do you think they were asking this question?
- Where do you think it comes from?
  - Hint Hint Take a look at Matthew 28:18

## Look at the parable.

- A Vineyard and tenants.
  - Isaiah 5:1-7 There's a parallel here.
- Do you treat Jesus like He has authority in/over your life?
  - The people thought that Jesus was going to come and kick the Romans out of Israel and establish a physical kingdom.
  - Take back the vineyard from the murderous tenants so to speak.
  - Have there been any times in your life when you would HONESTLY say that what you thought Jesus should do and what He actually did don't line up?

Who is Jesus? - He is the Chief Cornerstone.

Luke 20:19-26

- What are the dangers of that?
- You will always put your money where your true worship is.
  - How can we pray for your worship life?
  - How can we pray for your priorities when it comes to money?
- We all need a little bit of help in this area.

Who is Jesus? - Jesus is worthy of worship.

Luke 20:27-40

What is the purpose of marriage?

- Why is there no marriage in Heaven?

What is the purpose of resurrection?

"The relationship we have now will result in life later."

"Jesus didn't come here to make bad people good. He came to make dead people live."

What areas of your life/heart are dead and need resurrection?

Who is Jesus? - Jesus is Life.

Luke 20:41-47

What does the name, "Son of David" mean?

This is the question Jesus asked. Take a crack at it.

- How can Jesus be David's Lord if He is David's son?

Why is it so important that the Messiah was God the Son and not just another human hero?

Do you want to know who He really is?
