### 1. Genuine Christian Giving Has A Different Motive.

Our ultimate motive in giving is to honor God and advance His reputation and kingdom.

# 2. Genuine Christian Giving Is Done In A Different Manner.

We don't give according to our <u>emotions</u>, impulses, or surplus, we give according to our <u>faith</u> in God's goodness and provision.

# **A.** We give <u>Systematically</u>.

Genuine Christian generosity <u>begins</u> with giving the first  $\underline{10\%}$  or tithe of our income to the Lord through the local church for its ministry.
