1. We need properly focused \_\_\_\_\_

*I Peter 3:15 -* "**But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord**. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the **hope** that you have."

1 Peter 3:15 - But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord.

# 2. We need individually prepared \_\_\_\_\_

*I Peter 3:15* - ... "Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that **you** have."

#### 3. We need sincerely expressed \_\_\_\_\_

*I Peter 3:15-16 -* "but do this with **gentleness** and **respect**, <sup>16</sup> keeping a clear conscience so that those **who speak maliciously against your** good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander."

*Hebrews 4:13* - For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

*1 Peter 2:12* - Live such good lives among the pagans that, though they accuse you of doing wrong, they may **see your good deeds** and glorify God on the day he visits us.
