1. What is a Community Group?

Acts 2:42-47 - They <u>devoted themselves</u> to the apostles' <u>teaching</u> and to the <u>fellowship</u>, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. ⁴³ Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles. 44 All the believers were <u>together</u> and had everything in common. ⁴⁵ Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need. ⁴⁶ Every day they continued to <u>meet together in the temple courts</u>. They <u>broke bread in their homes and ate together</u> with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

ekklesia (Church) actually means: An assembly or gathering.

 Devoted means: To be earnest toward, to persevere, be constantly diligent, or to attend tirelessly all the exercises.

- Encourage means: To call near, invite, invoke.
- Build up means: To be a house-builder, construct, confirm.

Definition of "Togetherness": Warm fellowship, as among members of a family

1 Corinthians 12:12-13 - The body is <u>a unit</u>, though it is made up of <u>many parts</u>; and though all its parts are many, they form <u>one body</u>. So it is with Christ. ¹³ For we were all baptized by <u>one Spirit into one body</u> – whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free – and we were all given the one Spirit to drink.

Romans 12:4-8 - Just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, ⁵ so in Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. ⁶ We have different gifts, according to the grace given us. If a man's gift is prophesying, let him use it in proportion to his faith. ⁷ If it is serving, let him serve; if it is teaching, let him teach; ⁸ if it is encouraging, let him encourage; if it is contributing to the needs of others, let him give generously; if it is leadership, let him govern diligently; if it is showing mercy, let him do it cheerfully.

- Aaron is a type of Christ.
