How to deal with difficult people:

1. Refuse to be

Proverbs 12:16 - A fool shows his annovance at once, but a prudent man overlooks an insult.

Proverbs 10:12 - Hatred stirs up dissension, but **love covers** over all wrongs.

Luke 23:34 - Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."

Colossians 3:13 - Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

Matthew 22: 15, 18 - (Example of Jesus) The Pharisees plotted a way to trap him into saying something damaging...¹⁸ Jesus knew they were up to no good. He said, "Why are you playing these games with me? Why are you trying to trap me?" (MSG)

Proverbs 26: 21 - As charcoal to embers and as wood to fire, so is a guarrelsome man for kindling strife.

Proverbs 22:10 - Drive out the mocker, and out goes strife; guarrels and insults are ended.

Titus 3:10 - Warn a divisive person once, and then warn him a second time. After that, have nothing to do with him.

Romans 14:16 - Do not allow what you consider good to be spoken of as evil.

2 Corinthians 11:20-21 - In fact, you let people make slaves of you and cheat you and steal from you. Why, you even let them strut around and slap you in the face. ²¹ I am ashamed to say that we are too weak to behave in such a way. CEV

Galatians 5:1 - It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. <u>Stand firm</u>, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.

Romans 12:14 - Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse.
